

Regulations for Scholarships and Fellowships Scholarships and Concessions to Meritorious / Sports / Needy Students

Liberal concessions and incentives are available to deserving students in academic, sports and extra-curricular fields. The Scholarship Committee decides the concessions and incentives to be given after verification of the records of the candidates. The decision of the Principal is final.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships/ Concessions for Meritorious Students

For 1st Year students (BA/B.Sc/B.Com/BBA)
(On the basis of Marks in 10+2 Exam in any board)

Marks	Concession
95% and above	Full Freeship (only compulsory charges)
90%-94.9%	Rs. 11000/- concession annually
86%-89.9%	Rs. 6500/- concession annually
80%- 85.9%	Rs. 4500/- concession annually

For 2nd year and final year students of Under Graduate programmes and Post Graduate programmes (BA/B.Sc/B.Com/BBA/BCA/MA/M.Sc)
(On the basis of University Positions in 2nd Sem & 4th Sem Merit List)

Position	Concession
1 st in University	Full Free ship (only compulsory charges)
2 nd in University	50% (college fee)
3 rd in University	30% (college fee)
4 th to 10 th in University	15% (college fee)

Special Cases:

Father expired	Rs. 5000/- concession annually
Parentless	Rs. 10000/- concession annually
50% disability	Rs. 10,000/- concession annually
Sister concession	Rs. 2500/- concession annually

Sports Scholarship: Full freeship, hostel, coaching etc.

Defence Personnel: Full freeship for the ward of Martyr's and Rs. 10000 for the ward of Armed Personnel

Economically weak students: A student can take admission with Rs. 5000/-. The concession will be decided by the Scholarship Committee.
