3.6.1 Extension Activities carried out in the neighborhood sensitizing students to social issues for their holistic development and the impact thereof during the year

Besides this a compulsory **value added course –Social Outreach** is introduced for all the semester IV students, in which they take up projects on community welfare.

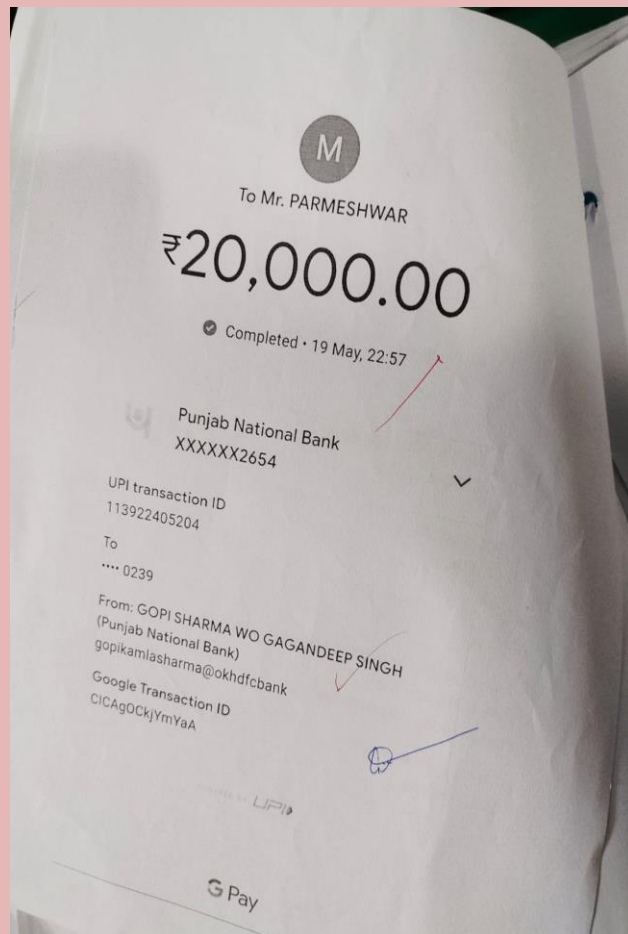
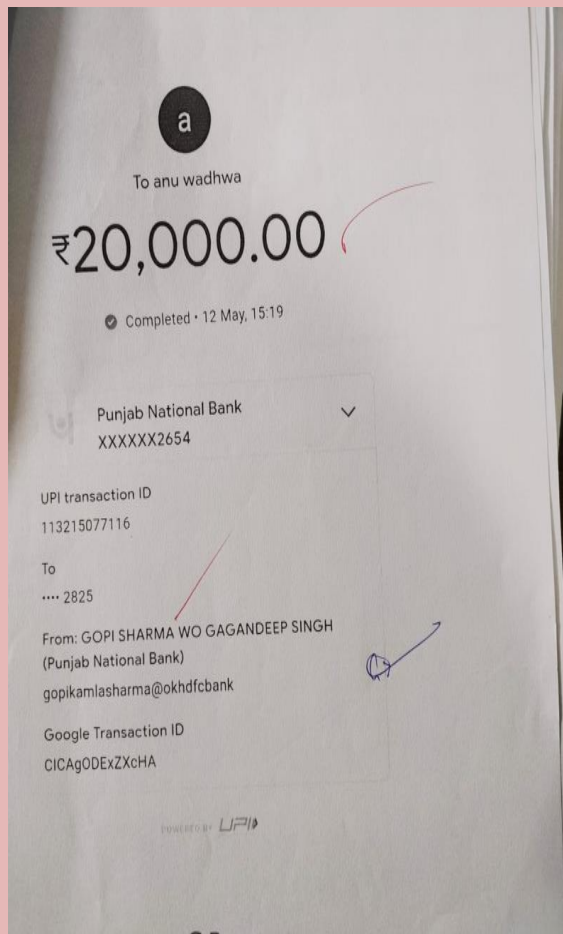
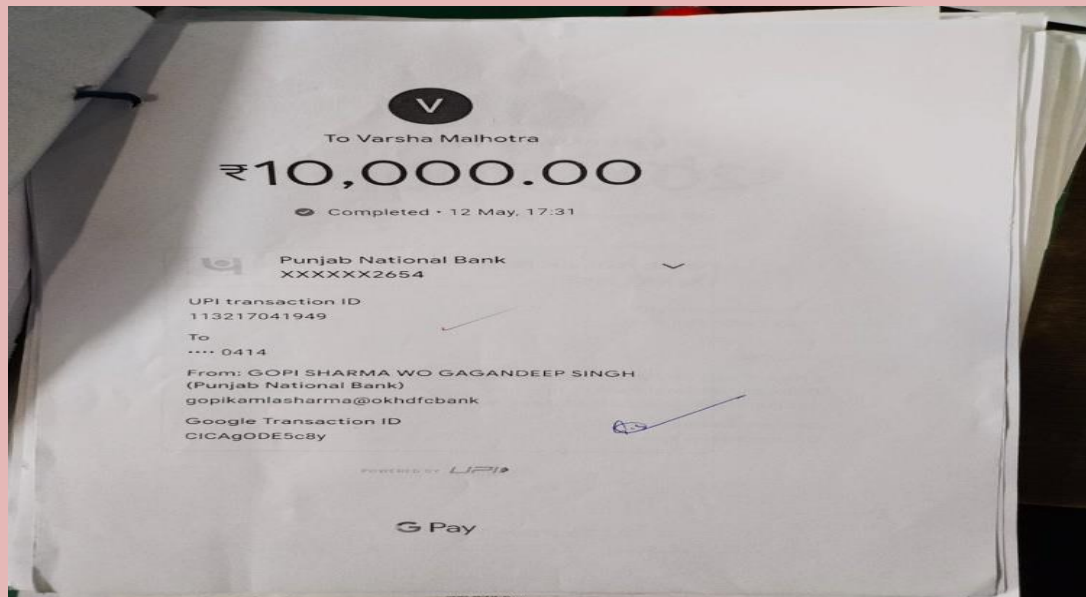
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Activity 3: Humanitarian Drive 'Helping Hands' 17.5.2021

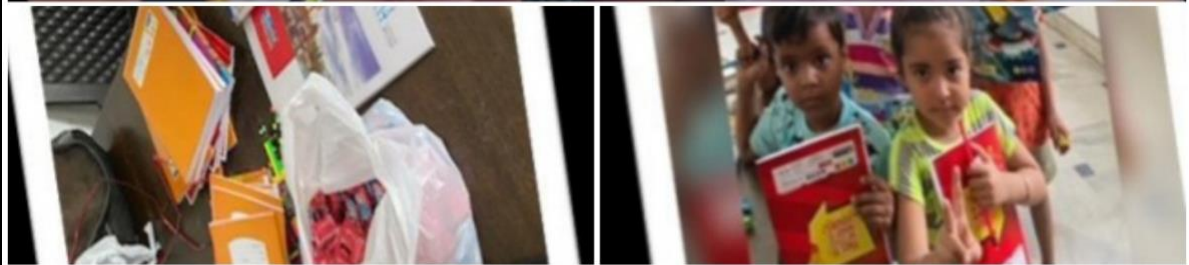

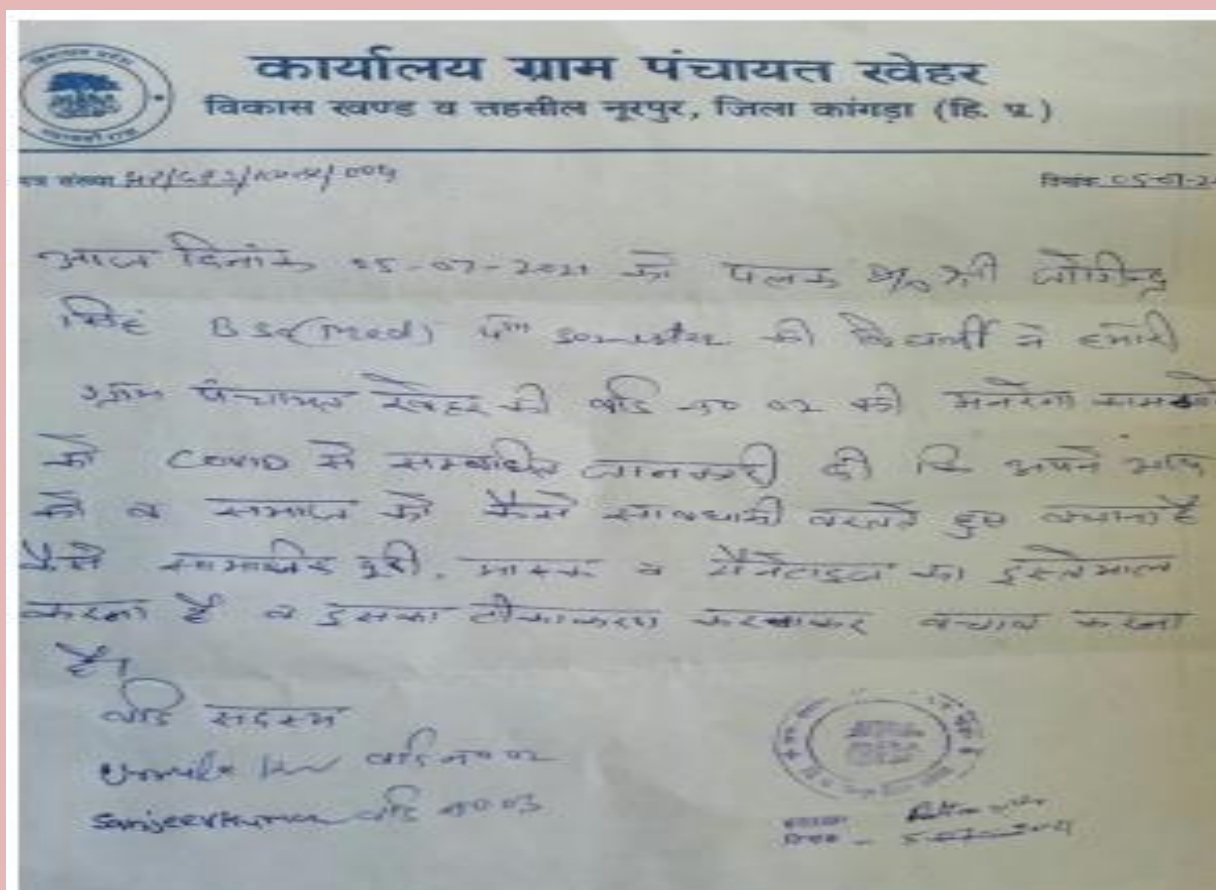
Area:- This project has been conducted in village Kuthandal of district Kangra Himachal Pradesh.

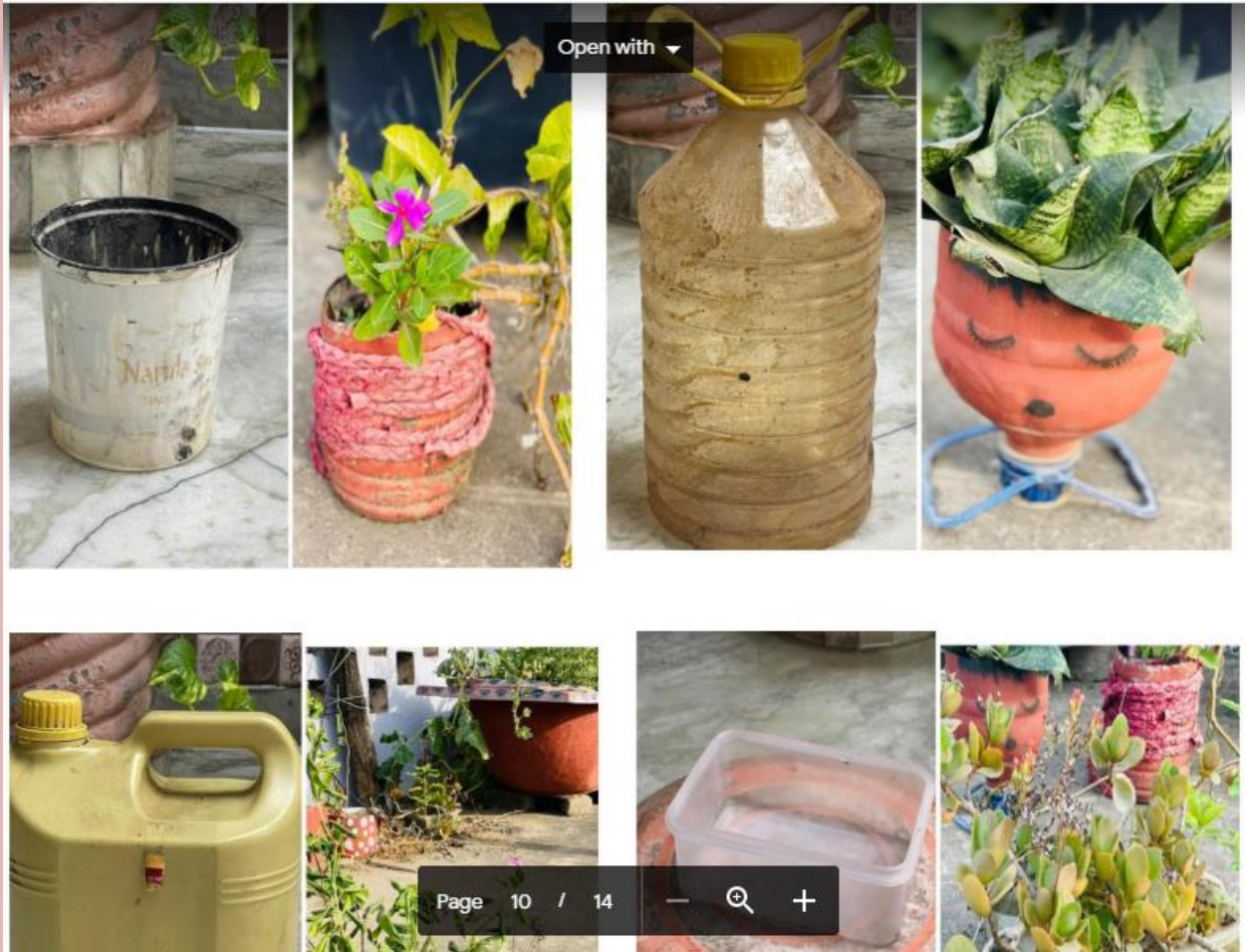
Activity No.7: Spreading Awareness about Recycling of Plastic and Segregation of Waste (10.6.2021)

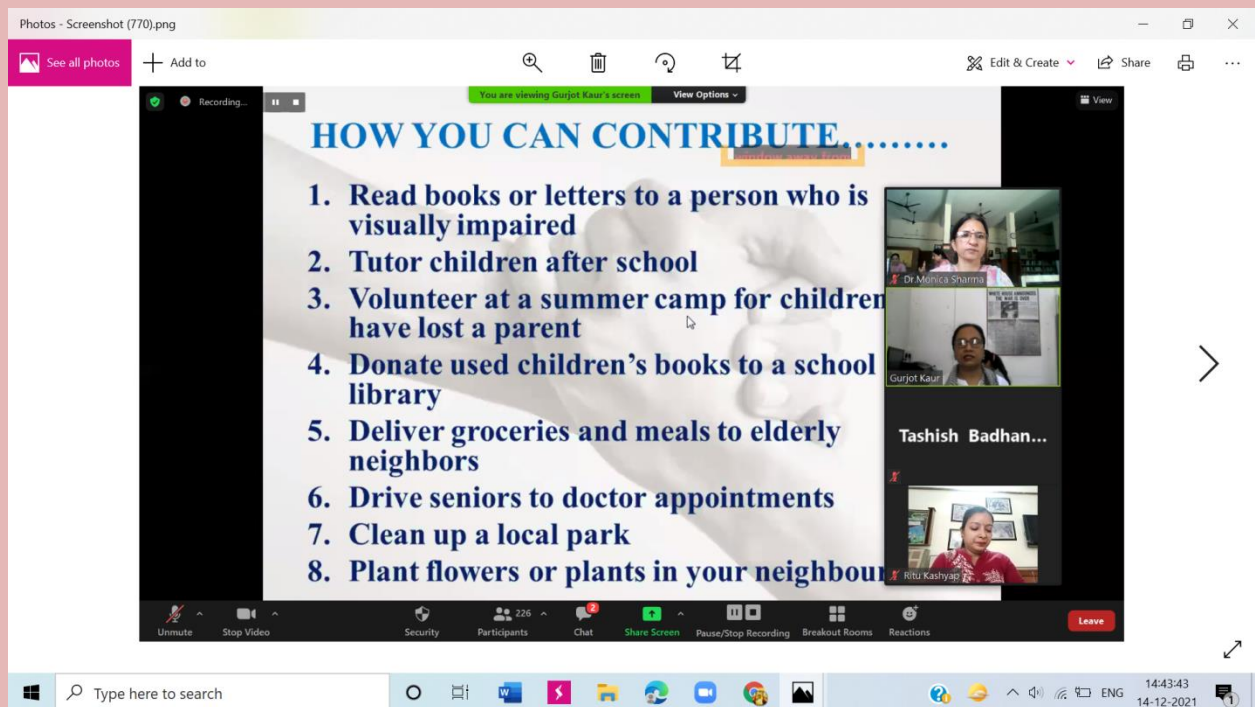
