3.6.1 Extension Activities carried out in the neighborhood sensitizing students to social issues for their holistic development and the impact thereof during the year

Besides this a compulsory value added course -Social Outreach is introduced for all the semester IV students, in which they take up projects on community welfare.





Activity 4: Humanitarian Drive 'Helping Hands' 17.5.2021


Area:- This project has been conducted in village Kuthandal of district Kangra Himachal Pradesh.




Activity No. 10 Social Outreach Value Added Programme


One week Social Awareness Camp on Solar Eclipse


Activity 16: Aatam Nirbhar Bharat-Innovation and Entrepreneurship (18th December 2020)






Activity 31: International E-Concave or Global Perspectives on Education in Covid-19 Times: Challenges and Opportunities:


Activity 50: Collective Prayers
