3.6.1 Extension Activities carried out in the neighborhood sensitizing students to social issues for their holistic development and the impact thereof during the year

For more than a century, Kanya Maha Vidyalaya has not only strived for expanding the landscape of learning but also making a meaningful contribution in the upliftment of the society. Epitomizing and synthesizing old values with modern education, KMV students have a heightened awareness of their productive role in the society. Through its various programmes KMV has reached out to the people not only in the city but also villages in the district. In this session 479 students took up projects under the broad themes of Environmental Protection & Sustainability, Literacy programmes, Science awareness, Food adulteration camps, running empathy corners in villages, vocational training and training camps in villages, visits to Old age homes, orphanages and Pingalwaras and working with NGOs and Municipal Corporation, Jalandhar. Students also performed Nukkad Nataks in Villages on Various Issues and Made Short Films to create awareness which were uploaded on YouTube. Activity 2: World Rose Day: Welfare of Cancer Patients (25-09-2021)

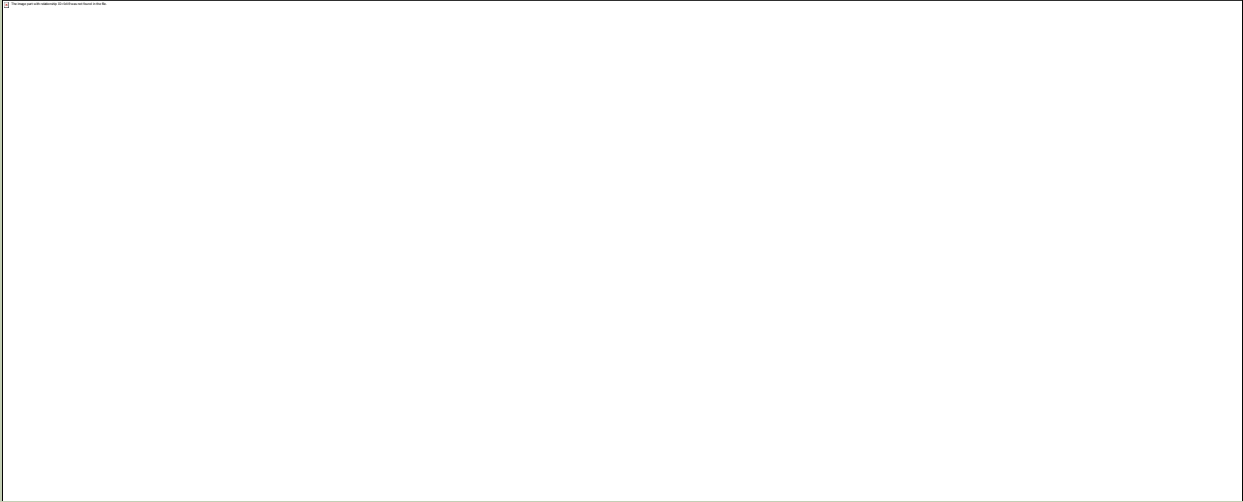
