3.6.1 Extension Activities carried out in the neighborhood sensitizing students to social issues for their holistic development and the impact thereof during the year

For more than a century, Kanya Maha Vidyalaya has not only strived for expanding the landscape of learning but also making a meaningful contribution in the upliftment of the society. 


Activity 4: Visit to Pingla Ghar, Jalandhar (28-10-2021)

Activity 42: Free of cost three month Vocational Training Programme in Cosmetology and Basic Computers (28-12-2021- September 2022)


