


Kanya Maha Vidyalaya


Feedback is collected on the basis of following parameters:

- Fifty-five percent of alumni find the course curriculum good and thirty-three percent of alumni find it excellent.




- Fifty-eight percent of alumni find the relevance of course content to the current job/ Real life is good and forty-two percent i.e. (twenty-one percent each) find it excellent and fair.

RELEVANCE OF COURSE CONTENT TO THE CURRENT JOB/ REAL LIFE




- Almost all the students prefer more fieldwork in the curriculum. Under Autonomous, internship & practical training have been incorporated into the syllabi depending upon the course curriculum. So, Sixty-four percent alumni find skill and practical component in the course structure good and twenty-one percent find it excellent.

SKILL AND PRACTICAL COMPONENTS IN THE COURSE STRUCTURE





QUALITY OF TEACHING AND LEARNING




- Sixty-one percent of alumni are find the co-curricular activities and development initiatives by the department or college good and twenty-four percent find it excellent.


CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES BY THE DEPARTMENT OR COLLEGE



- Majority of the students are satisfied with library resources and facilities. I.e. Forty-three percent of alumni find the library resources excellent and thirty-six percent find it good.




- Forty-six percent of alumni find the working of the placement cell excellent, thirty-nine percent of alumni find the working of the placement cell good and twelve percent find it fair.

WORKING OF THE PLACEMENT CELL




- Forty-three percent of alumni find the evaluation system excellent and forty-two percent find it good.

EVALUATION SYSTEM




- Fifty-six percent of alumni find the student-teacher interaction is good and twenty-nine percent find it excellent.

STUDENT-TEACHER INTERACTION





CAREER COUNSELLING AND STUDENT MENTORING




- Forty-three percent of alumni find the redressal of grievances mechanism excellent and forty-two percent find it good.
