


Report on Students' Feedback on Curriculum


All the responses on different aspects are presented below.

- Fifty-one percent of students find the curriculum of their concerned subjects challenging and forty- nine percent of students find it simple.





Does the curriculum provoke meaningful discussions in the classes?




- Seventy-two percent of students are in favor that their syllabi will be completed in time.

Do your syllabi get completed in time?




- Fifty-two percent of students are highly satisfied with the choice of subjects available and Thirty-five percent of students are satisfied with the choice of subjects available in curriculum.

Are you satisfied with the choice of subjects available?




- Students are happy with the initiative taken by the college to assign internal assessment in the final examination under Autonomy.

Do you favour internal assessment in the curriculum?




- Sixty percent of students find the examination system excellent and thirty-four percent of students find it good.

How do you view find the examination system?





- Majority of students find library materials more than adequate or adequate. Sixty-seven percent of students find it more than adequate and Twenty percent of students find it adequate.


How do you find the library materials and facilities for the course?

- Most of the students are satisfied with the lab facilities i.e Forty-one percent of students find the lab facilities more than adequate and Forty-eight percent of students find it adequate.


How do you view lab facilities in the college?



■ More than Adequate ■ Adequate ■ Inadequate


