


Commerce Students' Feedback on Curriculum



Kanya Maha Vidyalaya, Jalandhar values the feedback of students on the curriculum. Feedback has been randomly taken from 87 students from different commerce classes. Important findings are shared herewith.


- 52 percent of students find the curriculum of their concerned subjects challenging and 48 percent of students find it simple.




- 38 percent students feel that curriculum always provoke meaningful discussions in the classes and 48 percent students feel that curriculum mostly provoke meaningful discussions in the classes.




- 57 percentage of students agrees that syllabi is always completed in time while 35 percent agree that it is mostly completed in time.




- 23 percentage of students agrees that there are more than adequate library materials and facilities for the course and 68 percent consider it adequate. 9 percent students want improvement in library.




- 30 percent students are highly satisfied and 70 percent of students are satisfied by the availability of subject course.




- 84 percent of students favor internal assessment in the curriculum and only 16 percent students do not favor this.




- 29 percent of students find the examination system excellent and 60 percent of students find it good.




- 78 percent students say that fieldwork in the curriculum is adequate and 16 percent consider it more than adequate. 6 percent students want more exposure in field.




- 24 percent students find lab facilities to be excellent and 56 percent students find it good. 20 percent believe that it can be improved.



- 46 percent students find curriculum extremely helpful in enhancing career prospects and 53 percent find it somewhat helpful.



- 52 percent students find the curriculum extremely helpful in enhancing skill base and knowledge and 45 percent find it somewhat helpful.
