


Report on Alumni's' Feedback on Curriculum

Kanya Maha Vidyalaya, Jalandhar values the feedback of alumni's on the curriculum. Feedback has been randomly taken from Fifty-nine alumni's across different science streams. Important findings are shared herewith.

- Fifty five percent students are doing higher studies, eighteen percent students are self-employed, Eighteen percent students are doing service in the organization and 9 percent students are housewives.




Students have given assessments on following parameters

- Thirty Six percent alumni strongly finds the course curriculum excellent and other Sixty four percent alumni finds it good. No alumni finds that the course curriculum is average and needs any improvement.
- Eighty two percent of alumni advocate the relevance of course content to the current job/real life is excellent. Nine percent of alumni advocate the relevance of course content to the current job/real life is good whereas rest nine percent of alumni advocate the relevance of course content to the current job/real life is excellent.
- Thirty six percent of alumni find skill and practical components are excellent in the course structure whereas fifty five percent of alumni find that skill and

practical components are good in the course structure. Rest nine percent of alumni find that skill and practical components are fair in the course structure.

- Sixty-four percent of alumni find quality of teaching and learning is good whereas thirty six percent alumni finds the quality of teaching and learning excellent. No alumni views negative against the quality of teaching and learning.
- Thirty-six percent alumni finds that the co-curricular activities and development initiatives by the department/college are excellent. Forty five percent alumni finds that the co-curricular activities and development initiatives by the department/college are good whereas Nineteen percent alumni finds that the co-curricular activities and development initiatives by the department/college are fair.
- Thirty six percent of alumni find that the library facilities are excellent. Forty-five percent of alumni find that the library facilities are good. Nineteen percent of alumni find that the library facilities are fair.
- Sixty four percent alumni advocates that Infrastructure and lab facilities are good whereas nineteen percent alumni finds the Infrastructure and lab facilities are excellent. Nine percent alumni advocates that Infrastructure and lab facilities are fair and eight percent alumni advocates that Infrastructure and lab facilities are average.
- Eighty One percent of alumni consider working of placement cell is good. Nineteen percent of alumni consider working of placement cell is excellent.
- Fifty four percent of alumni advocate that evaluation system of the institution is good and twenty seven percent of alumni finds it good whereas others find it excellent. Eighteen percent of alumni finds it good whereas others find it fair.
- Sixty Four percent of alumni observe excellent student-teacher interaction and other thirty six percent find it good.
- Twenty seven percent of alumni find career counseling and student mentoring are excellent and Seventy three percent find it good.
- Seventy three percent alumni find redressal of grievances mechanism is good. Eighteen percent alumni find redressal of grievances mechanism is excellent whereas Nine percent alumni find redressal of grievances mechanism is fair.
- According to analysis, sixty four percent alumni finds that the overall campus environment is excellent whereas twenty seven percent of alumni finds it good. Rest nine percent alumni finds that the overall campus environment is fair.
