


Report on Students' Feedback on Curriculum




- Seventy two percent of students find the curriculum of their concerned subjects are simple and twenty eight percent of students find the syllabus of their concerned subjects are challenging. No student can find the syllabi dull.




- Fifty eight percent students feel that curriculum mostly provoke meaningful discussions in the classes. Twenty eight percent students feel that the curriculum always provoke meaningful discussions in the class and thirteen percent feel that sometimes the curriculum provoke meaningful discussions.




- Fifty three percent students agree that the syllabus is always completed on time. Forty Seven students agree that mostly the syllabi gets completed on time.




- Sixty seven percent students agree that they find the library materials and facilities for the course adequate and thirty three percent students find the library material and facilities are more than adequate. No student disagree with the library material and facilities for the course.




- Eighty Six percent students are satisfied with the choice of subject course whereas fourteen percent students are highly satisfied with the choice of the subject course. No students are dissatisfied with the choice of subject availability.



- Ninety two percent students favor internal assessment in the curriculum. Eight percent students aren't in the favor of internal assessment in the curriculum.




- Twenty five percent students finds that the examination system is excellent and sixty seven percent students find that the examination system is good. Eight percent students find the examination system average.




- Almost all the students prefer more fieldwork in the curriculum. Under Autonomous, internship & practical training have been incorporated into the syllabi depending upon the course curriculum. Twenty five percent of students find practical and field work in the curriculum is more than adequate and seventy-two percent students find it adequate. Three percent students find it inadequate.

How do you view fieldwork and practical component in the curriculum?




- Forty two percent students of Department of Computer Science find lab facilities to be excellent and Fifty three percent of students find the facilities to be good. Five percent students find the lab facilities to be average.

- Maximum number of students of Computer Science Department find the curriculum helpful in their career prospects. Sixty seven percent of students find curriculum extremely helpful in enhancing career prospects and thirty three percent students find it somewhat helpful. No student agrees that the curriculum is not helpful


Do you think your present curriculum will help you in career prospects & employability?
