


Report on Students' Feedback on Curriculum




Fifty-Nine percent of students find the curriculum of their concerned subjects challenging and forty percent of students find it simple.




- Fifty percent students feel that curriculum mostly and Thirty three-Percent feel curriculum always provoke meaningful discussions in the classes.




- Fifty-eight percentages of students agrees that syllabi are always completed in time.




- Seventy-two percentages of students agrees that there are adequate library materials and facilities for the course.




- Sixty-one percentages of students are satisfied and Thirty-nine percentages of students are highly satisfied by the availability of subject course.




- Eighty –nine percentages of students favor internal assesment in the curriculum.




- Forty-five percent of students find the examination system excellent and Forty-Five percent of students find it good.




Almost all the students prefer more fieldwork in the curriculum. Under Autonomous, internship & practical training have been incorporated into the syllabi depending upon the course curriculum. Twenty nine percent of students find practical/field work more than adequate and sixty nine percent find it adequate.




- Thirty one percentages of students find lab facilities to be excellent and other Fifty seven percentages of students find it good.



- Majority of students, seventy three percentages find the curriculum Extremely helpful in their career prospects. Twenty percent of students find curriculum somewhat helpful in enhancing career prospects and one percent find it not so helpful.



- Seventy-one percent of students find the curriculum extremely helpful in enhancing skill base and knowledge and Twenty-nine percent find it somewhat helpful.
