


Report on Students' Feedback on Curriculum



- Eighty percent of students find the curriculum of their concerned subjects challenging and twenty percent find it simple.




- Fifty nine percent students feel that curriculum mostly provoke meaningful discussions in the classes

Does the curriculum provoke meaningful discussions in the classes?




- Forty-eight percentages of students agrees that syllabi is always completed in time.

Do your syllabi get completed in time?




- Eighty-nine percentage of students agrees that there are adequate library materials and facilities for the course.

How do you find the library materials and facilities for the course?




- Seventy-four percentage of students are satisfied by the availability of subject course.

- Ninety –one percentage of students favor internal assessment in the curriculum




- Thirty-eight percent of students find the examination system excellent and fifty two percent of students find it good.




- Almost all the students prefer more fieldwork in the curriculum. Under Autonomous, internship & practical training have been incorporated into the syllabi depending upon the course curriculum. Twenty seven percent of students find practical/field work more than accurate and seventy-three percent find it adequate.

How do you view fieldwork and practical component in the curriculum?




- Twenty Eight percentages of students find lab facilities to be excellent and other Fifty seven percentages of students find it good.

How do you find the lab facilities in the college?





Suggestions

1. CP-I and CP-II should not be taken.
2. Physical Chemistry as a subject should be included in B.Sc Biotech 5 rather than B.Sc Biotech 6.
3. Separate extra classes should be arranged for DBT-JRF, ICMR, IIT-JAM, CSIR-NET.
4. B.Sc-B.Ed integrated course should be introduced.

5. Separate washrooms are required.
6. Saturday off are requested.
7. NEET preparation classes should be arranged.
8. M.Sc Biotechnology and Forensic science should be introduced.
