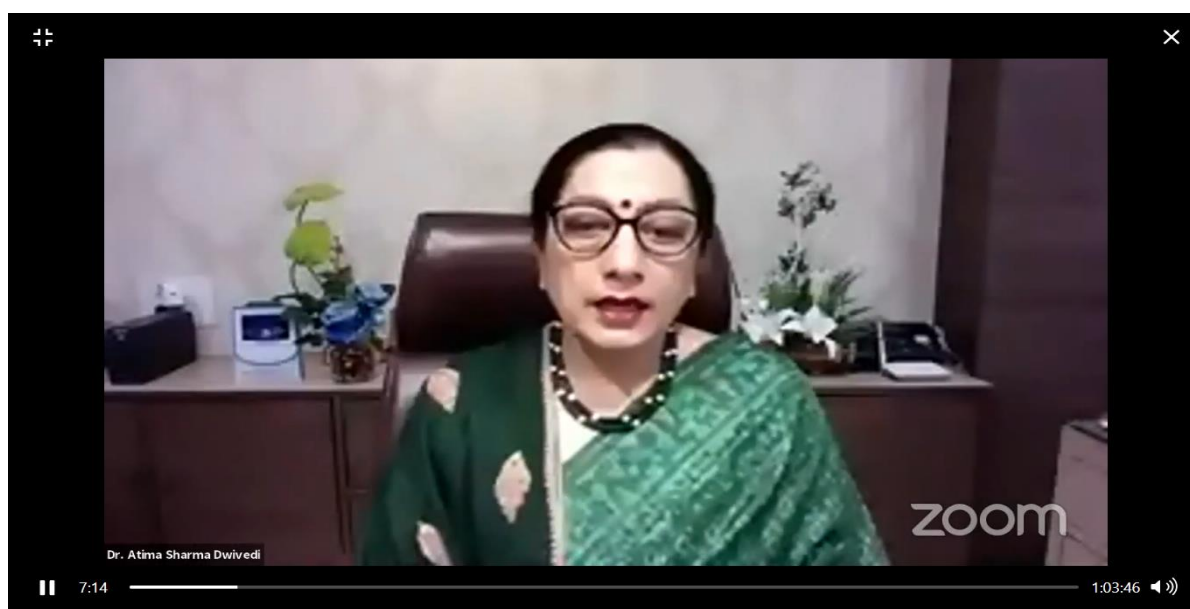

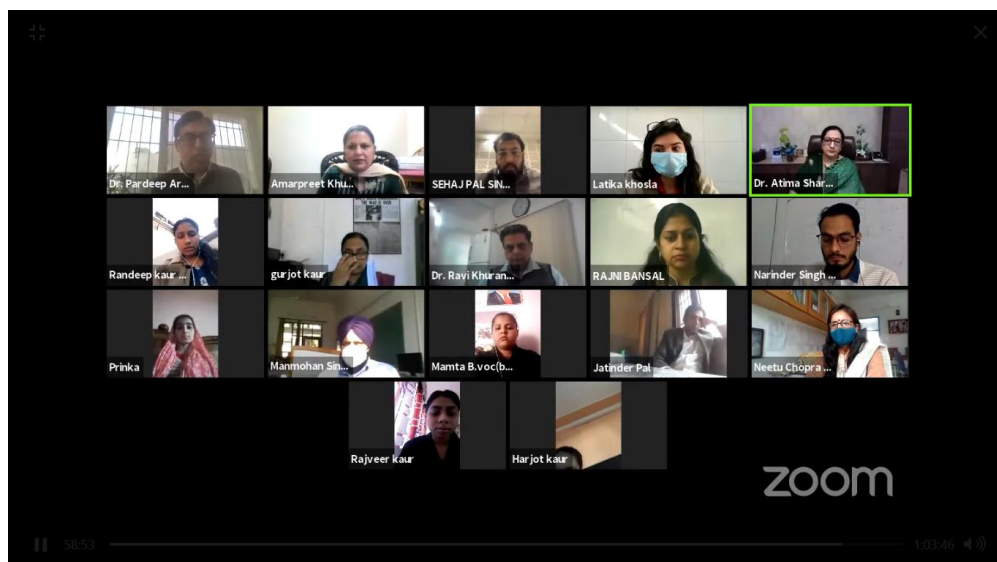
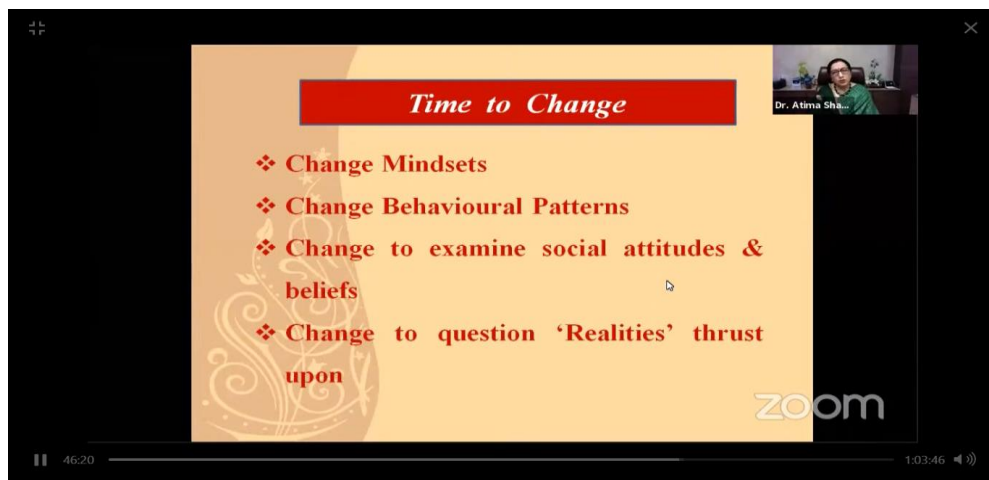


Programme Schedule of Gender Sensitization Program

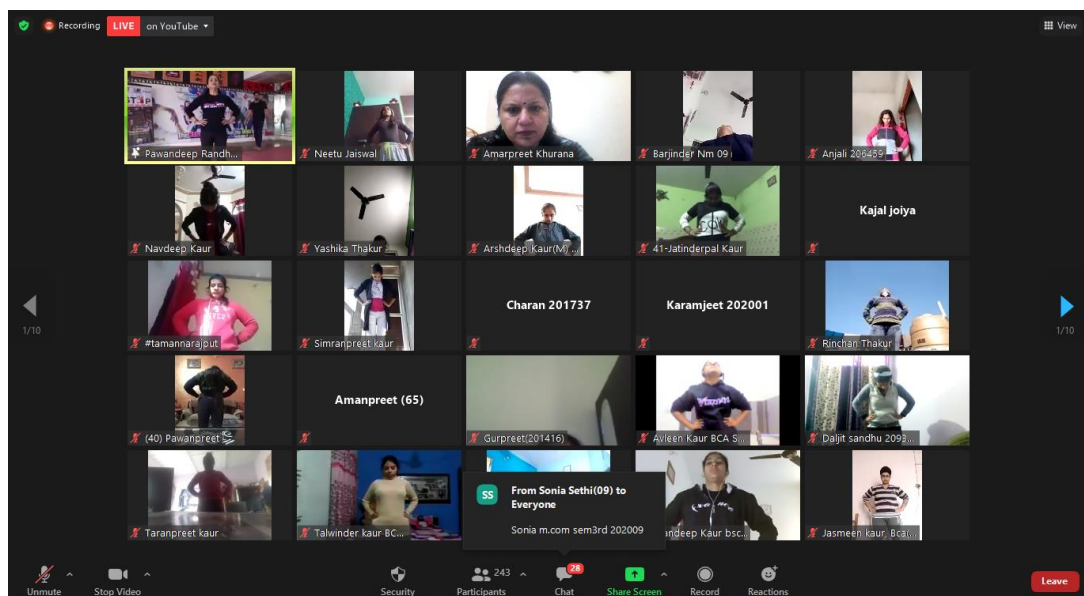
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Prof. Atima Sharma Dwivedi -Inaugural Talk

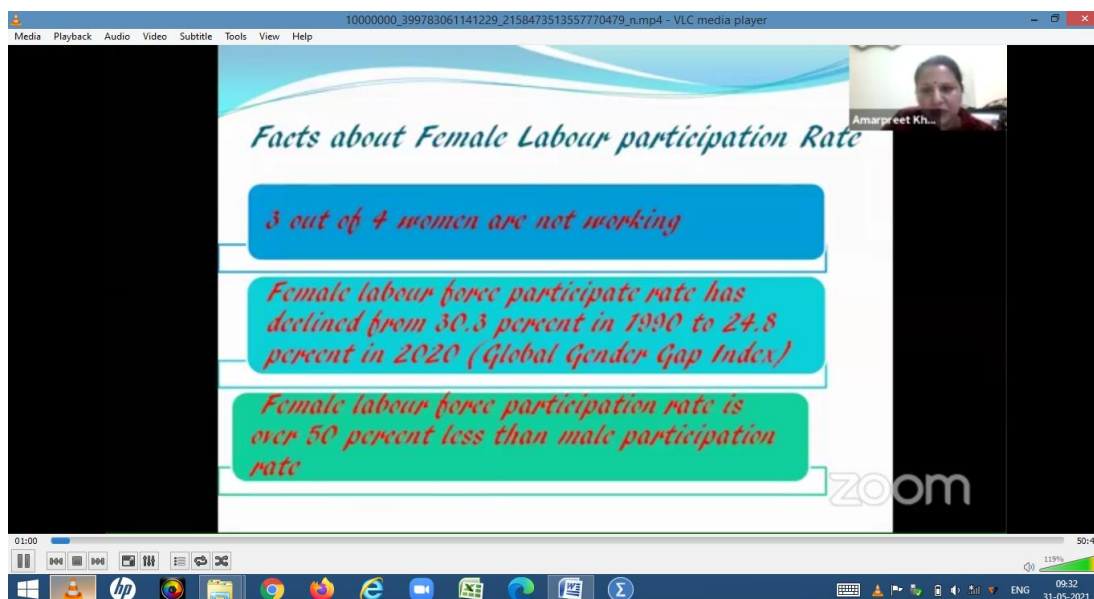

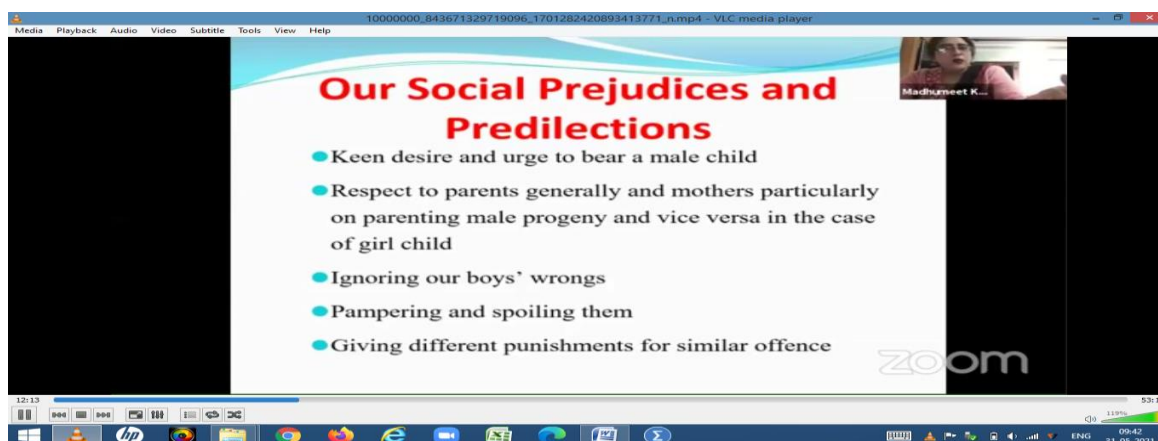
Gender Dimension in Economics participation and Wage Gap

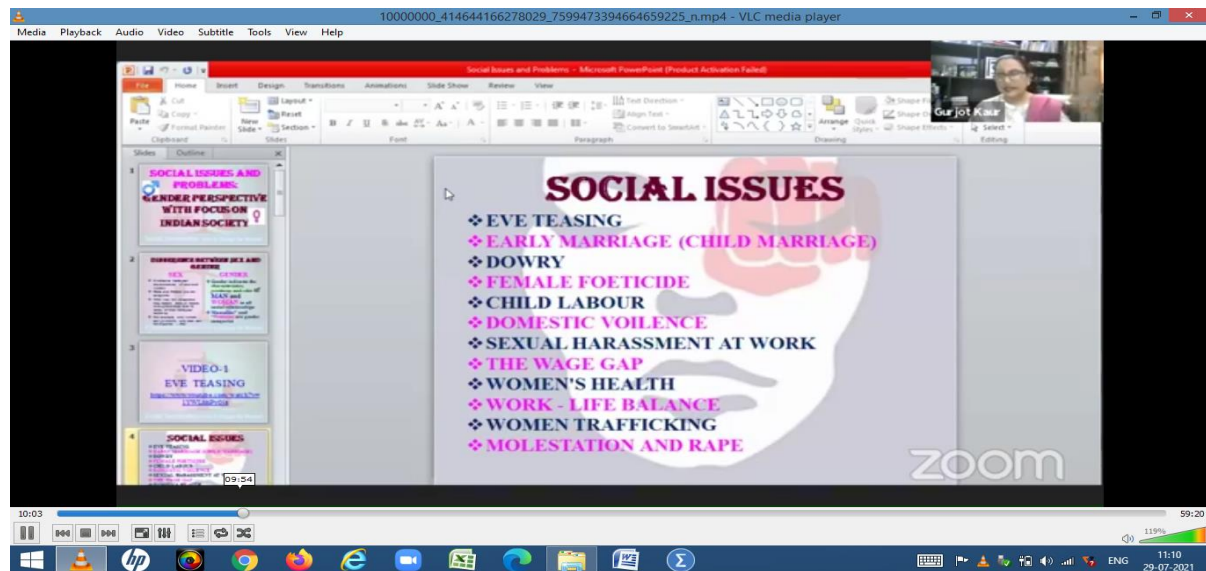
Cultural Roles and Gender Sensitivity

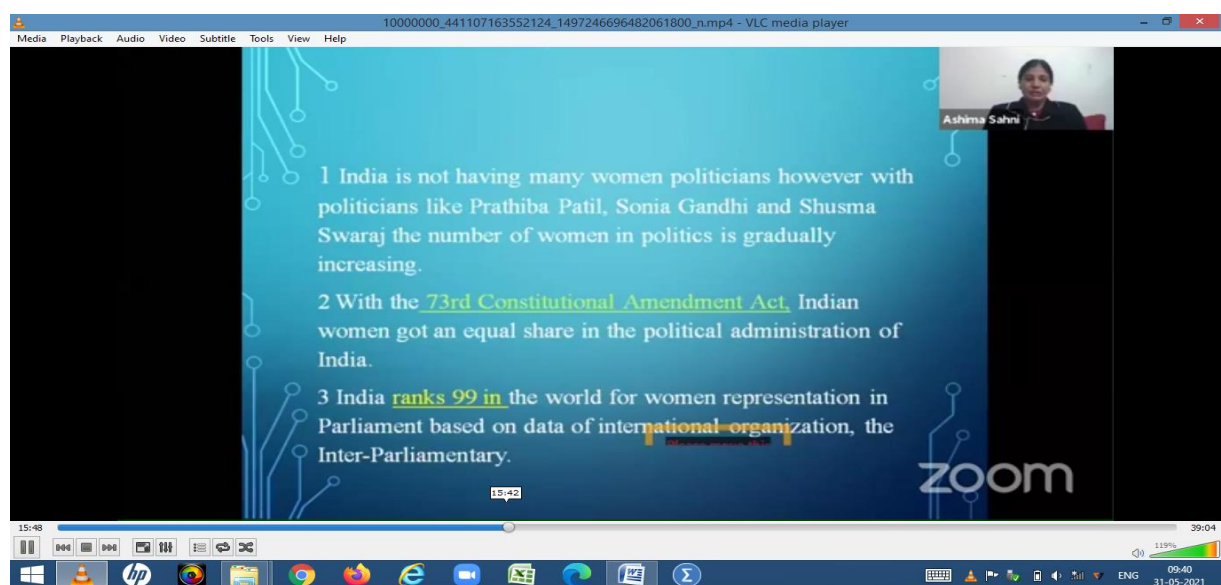


Social issues and Problems: Gender perspectives with focus on Indian society

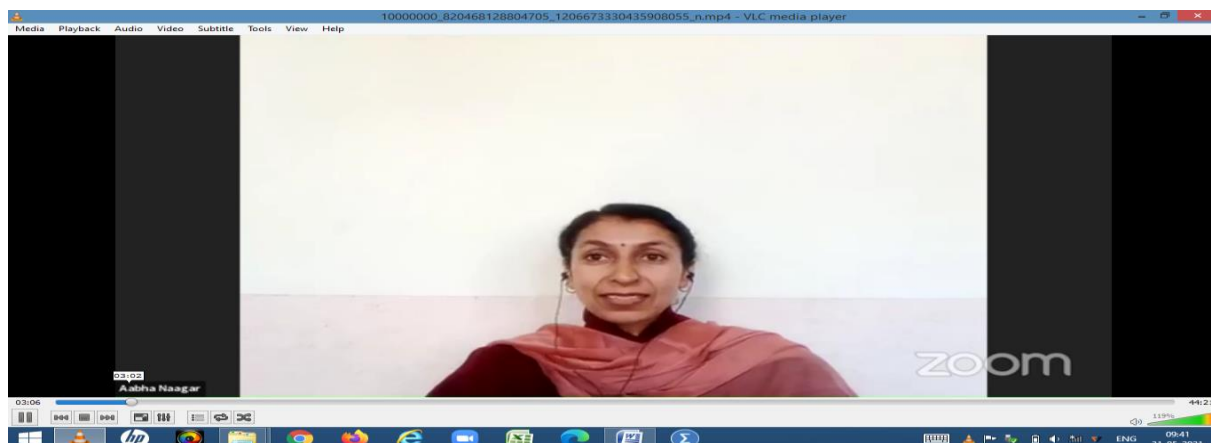

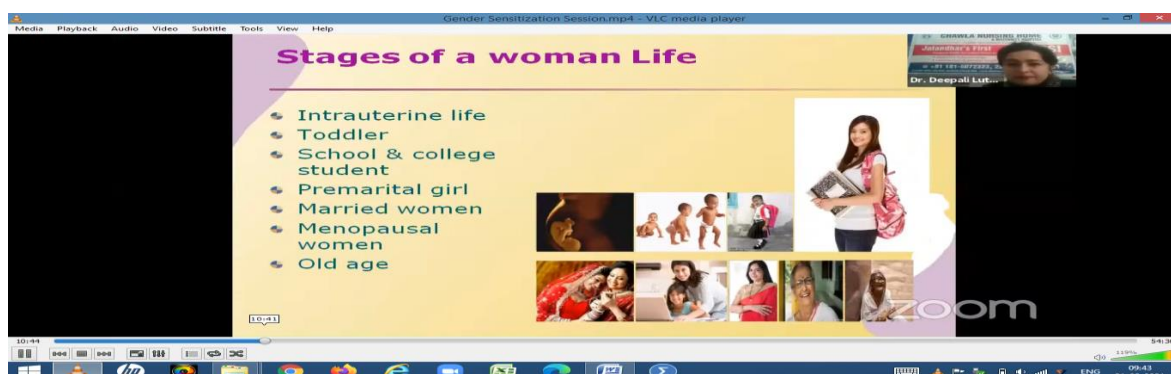
Constitutional and Legal rights of women

Gender issues and Health care

Dr. Deepali Luthra, a renowned Gynaecologist from Chawla Nursing and Maternity Hospital, Jalandhar deliberated upon an important topic - Gender issues and Health care. She started her conversation with Ribbon movement for Healthcare and told the students significance of different coloured Ribbons in Medical Profession. She apprised students about various stages of women life and her health issues that they face with age like menstrual problems, Hormonal problems, Anaemia, bone health etc. She said women health issues needs to be considered as a healthy women means a healthy family. Disease like Anaemia is very prevalent in girls because of monthly loss of blood so a proper diet and extra care is required. In this patriarchal society women take care of family but forget about her own health. So there is need to eliminate the gender gap and men should come forward to gave a very conducive and protective environment to women. Women health doesn't mean merely absence of disease but a complete physical, mental and social well being.
