

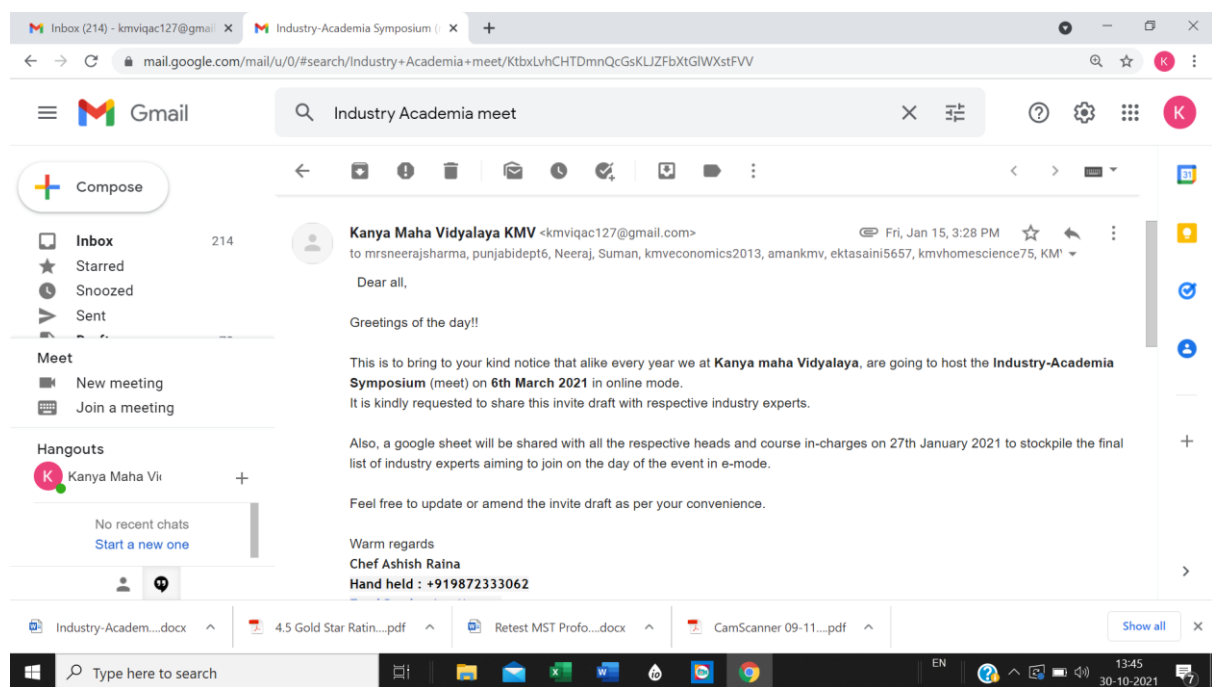
KMV Organises e-Symposium on Industry Academia Interaction on 6th March 2021.

The e-Symposium was organised by DDU Kaushal Kendra of KMV. There was an

The event began with the Holy Lamp Lighting Ceremony.
