

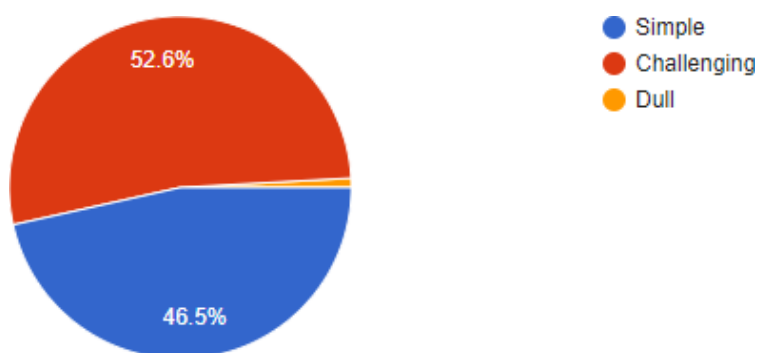
# **Report on Students' Feedback on Curriculum**

**2020-21**

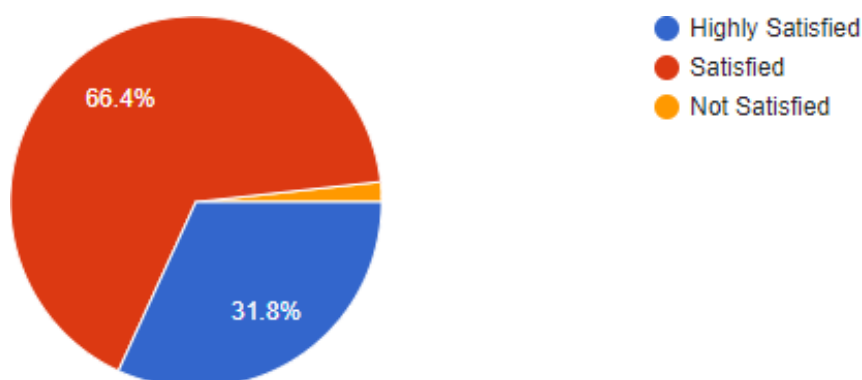

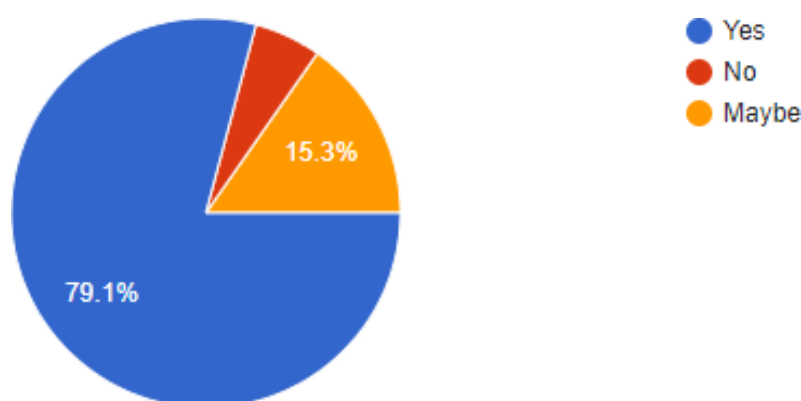
- **Fifty three percent students find curriculum of their concerned subjects challenging and forty seven percent students find it simple.**

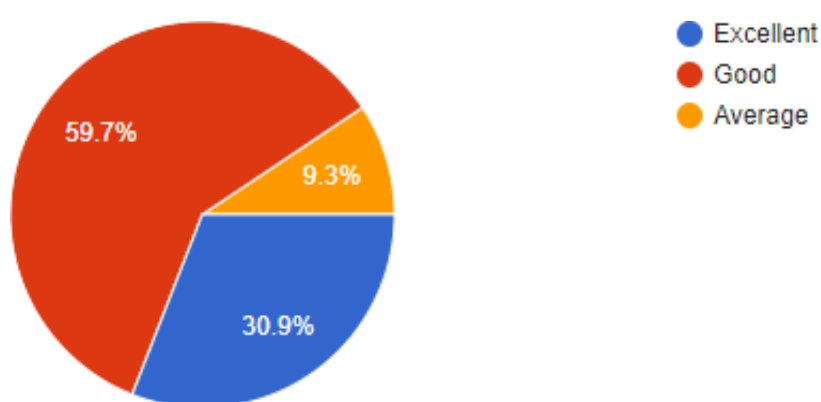

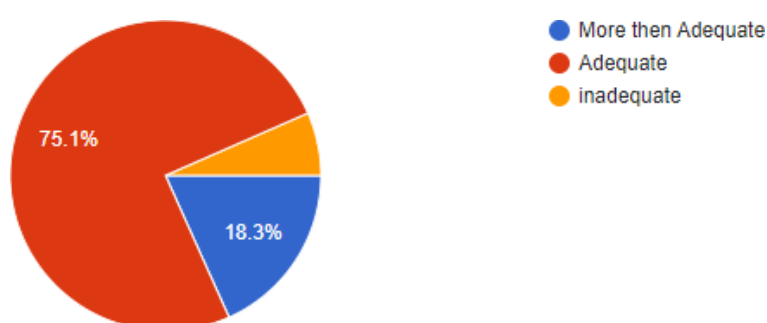


- **Almost all the students prefer more field work in curriculum. Under Autonomous , internship &**

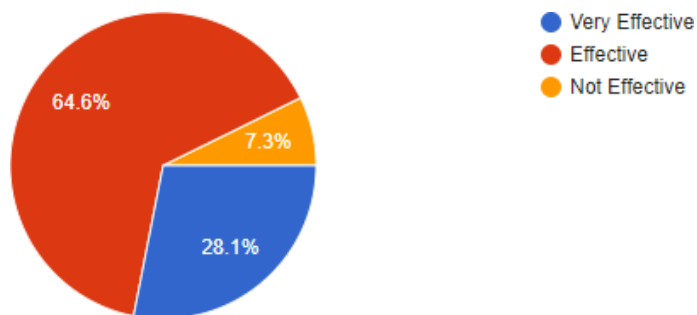

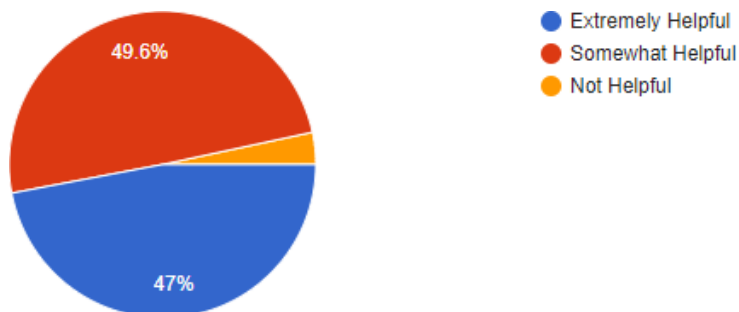

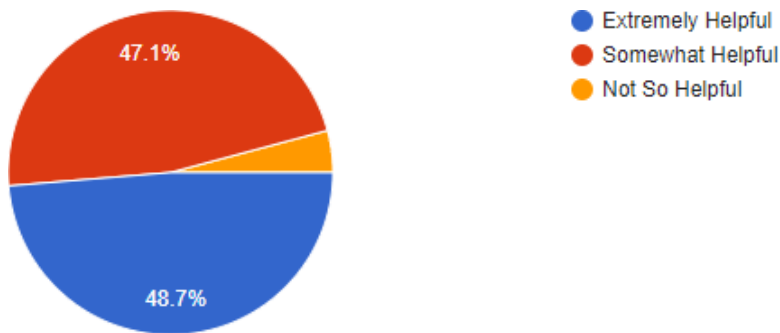
- **Sixty five percent students find online teaching effective and twenty eight percent students find it effective**

## **Suggestions**

- **Students from faculty of humanities suggested to incorporate skill oriented subjects in B.A. as they wish to opt one or two skill oriented subjects along with traditional subjects.**
- **In B.Com Hons , there is industrial training in one semester as a part of curriculum . BBA students recommended to introduce industrial training as part of curriculum in their syllabus also.**
- **More focus should be given on practical knowledge, field work, projects and training sessions.**
- **Science students have a very lengthy time-table and they suggested to organize sport activities for non-sports students.**
- **More skill oriented short term courses and B.Ed. should be started**
