IBPS PO Syllabus and Exam Pattern 2021

IBPS PO Syllabus & Exam Pattern 2021: The Exam Dates for IBPS PO 2021 has been released by **IBPS**. The preliminary exam of IBPS PO 2021 is scheduled to be held on **9th, 10th, 16th & 17th October 2021** and Mains Exam is scheduled on **27th November 2021**. To ace IBPS PO Exam, it is necessary to know the Exam pattern and detailed syllabus of this exam. This will help you to prepare judiciously for IBPS PO Exam. Let's understand the **IBPS PO Syllabus and Exam Pattern 2021** one by one.

IBPS PO Syllabus & Exam Pattern

IBPS released new exam pattern for **IBPS PO** Exam. The exam pattern will be similar for IBPS PO 2021 as well. There is **separate sectional timing for each sections in preliminary exam**. IBPS PO 2021 Exam will be conducted in **three phases: Preliminary Exam, Mains Exam and Interview Process**. It is mandatory for a candidate to clear each level of examination to get selected to the post of Probationary Officer in multiple Public Sector Banks.

IBPS PO Exam Pattern 2021

IBPS PO Preliminary Exam Pattern 2021

The **IBPS PO preliminary examination will be** conducted online and candidates are allocated total duration of **1 hour** to complete the preliminary exam. It consists of **3 sections with a total of 100 questions** and maximum score of **100 marks**. There is negative marking in IBPS PO preliminary exam and **0.25 marks are deducted for each wrong answer** attempted by a candidate. It is necessary to clear the cut-off in all 3 sections to qualify for the IBPS PO Main exam.

IBPS PO Mains Exam Pattern 2021

• **Introduction of Descriptive Paper:** Just like SBI PO 2021 Exam, IBPS introduced Descriptive Paper in its Mains Examination where candidates will be judged on their written skills. An essay and a letter will be given to candidates to write that will constitute of 25 marks and that has to be completed in a time span of 30 minutes.

- The overall time allotted for each section has also been changed.
- **No separate paper will be conducted for Computer Applications. Reasoning is teamed up with Computer Aptitude** section and this entire section will contain **45 questions of a total of 60 marks.**
- The **overall time allotted for IBPS PO 2021 Mains Exam** has also been changed from **140 minutes to 180 minutes.**

IBPS PO 2021 Interview Process

Candidates who qualify the Mains Exam are finally called for the Interview Process by IBPS. The Interview Process will constitute of **100 marks** and the minimum marks for qualifying this round will be **40% which is reduced to 35% for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/PWD categories.**

Penalty for Wrong Answers:

0.25 marks will be deducted for every question attempted wrong by a candidate in both IBPS PO 2021 Preliminary Exam and IBPS PO 2021 Mains Exam. There will be no deduction of marks for a question left blank/unattempted by a candidate.

Final Selection

The final selection of the candidate to the post of Probationary Officer will be made by taking into consideration the cumulative score of **Mains Exam and the interview Process.** The weightage of both these phases of examination will be in the **ratio 80:20 respectively.** A merit list will be generated after the Interview Process of IBPS PO 2021 Exam has been

conducted. Candidates who make it to the list will be thus offered the joining letter by the Bank of their choice.

IBPS PO Syllabus 2021

IBPS PO Syllabus 2021: To ace IBPS PO 2021 exam, it is really necessary to know the detailed **IBPS PO Syllabus**. The syllabus is a bit different for IBPS PO 2021 Preliminary Exam and IBPS PO 2021 Mains Exam. Let's have a look at the syllabus of both these phases of IBPS PO Exam:

IBPS PO Prelims Syllabus 2021

IBPS PO Prelims Exam Syllabus: IBPS PO Preliminary Exam is the primary selection round of IBPS PO 2021 Exam. Candidates who clear the preliminary exam are eligible to appear for the mains exam. The Preliminary Exam of IBPS PO comprises of **three major sections: Reasoning, Quantitative Aptitude and English Language**.

IBPS PO Mains Exam Syllabus: The mains exam is the important phase of IBPS PO 2021 Exam. Maximum weightage is given to score obtained by candidate in IBPS PO Mains Exam in the final selection to the post of Probationary Officer. The Mains Examination of IBPS PO exam 2021 consists of **4 + 1 sections: Reasoning & Computer Aptitude, English Language, Quantitative, Aptitude & General Awareness**. Just like SBI PO 2021, IBPS has introduced a **descriptive paper in its mains exam** for selection of candidates to the post of Probationary officer.

UPSC Exam Pattern 2021 For Prelims, Mains & Interview

UPSC Civil Services Examination, also known as IAS Exam, is a three-stage examination consisting of Prelims, Mains, and Interview. It is conducted by the Union Public Service

Commission (UPSC) to recruit suitable candidates for IAS, IPS, IFS, and other allied services.

Broadly, UPSC conducts the Civil Service Examination in three phases namely:

Preliminary Examination

Main Examination

Personality Test (Interview)

Candidates who qualify for all the rounds are recommended for joining the civil services in India. Each round is an elimination round, so you need to qualify each one in order to appear for the next one. Now, let us discuss the UPSC Exam Pattern 2021 along with the marking scheme for each of the papers in different rounds.

UPSC Exam Pattern For IAS Preliminary Examination

UPSC CSE Prelims consists of two papers namely General Studies I and CSAT (General Studies Paper-II). While CSAT is qualifying in nature, the marks obtained in the General Studies paper determine your selection for UPSC Mains. It means your score in the General Studies Paper will be considered for the Prelims cutoff.

Additionally, there is negative marking for the wrong answers. 1/3rd of the marks allotted for the question would be deducted as a penalty for marking the wrong answer. However, if you do not attempt the question, there will be no deductions. Hence, you should take only calculated risk when it comes to marking doubtful questions.

Now, let us look at the UPSC Exam pattern for Prelims 2021:

In reference to the UPSC Exam Pattern, the following points should be kept in mind while appearing for IAS Exam 2021:

It is mandatory for all the candidates to appear for both the exams viz General Studies and CSAT to qualify for the Mains.

The score obtained in the Prelims will not be added to the final score. UPSC CSE Prelims 2021 will be just for screening purposes.

The question paper of Prelims will be bilingual. It will have questions written both in Hindi and English Language.

There is a negative marking of 1/3rd for every incorrect answer in both the papers.

UPSC Exam Pattern 2021 For IAS Main Examination

The UPSC Exam Pattern for the Mains Exam is tabulated below. The IAS Mains Exam consists of two types of papers viz qualifying and merit-ranking. Paper A and Paper B namely the Language paper and English paper will be qualifying in nature. The marks obtained in these papers will not be added to marks that may determine your rank. All the other papers will be evaluated for merit purposes.

The following points should be kept in mind while preparing for UPSC CSE Mains 2021:

Except for language papers, Paper A and Paper B, scores in all the other papers will determine your rank.

Hence, your score will be out of a total of 1750 marks.

It is mandatory to score at least 25% in each paper to be evaluated while the final selection.

Candidates will be required to write the answers in the answer sheets provided by the UPSC. No extra sheets will be provided.

You are pleased to inform you that you have qualified for Junior Research Fellowship (JRF) and eligibility for Assistant Professor in the Joint CSIR-UGC Test conducted in December 2019. The tenure of fellowship is five years and it commences from the date of declaration of NET result, i.e. 28th January, 2020 (or) from the date of admission under M.Phil./Ph.D. (or) from the date of award of M.Phil./Ph.D. programme, whichever is later. The amount of financial assistance offered under the scheme is mentioned in Annexure A.

The beneficiary is required to get admission and registration for regular and full time M.Phil./Ph.D. course in a University/Institution/College recognized by UGC, at the first available opportunity but not later than three years from the date of declaration of the award letter. University/Institution/College is requested to process for award of JRF based on this letter, in accordance with the procedure available on www.nta.ac.in.

It may be noted that the fellowship amount shall be disbursed through Central Bank to bank account of the Assistant (or) bank details. UGC had developed a dedicated web portal (www.ugc.ac.in) for capturing data of the awardees. The University/College/Institution will link the data of the awardee with the master data on the UGC web portal with unique Master ID. The data which have already been provided to them along with the payments. The University/College/Institution shall provide the information in the master data regarding monthly payment confirmation, JRA, up-gradation, resignation etc. of the beneficiaries on monthly basis. Based on the data updated on UGC web portal by the concerned University/College/Institution, the payment of the fellowship will be made in the beneficiary's (banked) process available at <http://www.ugc.ac.in>.

It may also be noted that UGC had proposed to link "AADHAAR" with bank account of students so that there can be direct cash transfer and effective disbursement of fellowship into bank account of the student. In this regard, Secretary, UGC had already requested the government to help students in Aadhaar enrolment vide D.O. No. F.14-54/2011 (CPP-II) dated 31.01.2013.

It may please be noted that the award is liable to be cancelled by implementing/issuing agency and it will also attract legal action against the Assistant in the following cases:

- If the candidate is found to be ineligible to receive the award at any point during the entire duration of fellowship.
- Misconduct of Awardee.
- Excess use of property of research work.
- Failure to use a nomination related to M.Phil./Ph.D.
- Excess use of other fellowship or grant from other sources.
- Continuation of fee.

The certificate of eligibility for Assistant Professor has been uploaded on <http://www.ugc.ac.in>. The eligibility of the candidate is to be verified by the concerned institution/approving authority. The category under which the candidate had appeared may be verified from NTA.

OFFER OF APPOINTMENT

We are pleased to inform that you have been selected for appointment in **Chandigarh Circle** as a Probationary Officer in our Bank.

2. Your date of joining the Bank has been fixed as **30.03.2021**. Please make it convenient to report on that date to **Assistant General Manager (HR), State Bank of India, Local Head Office, Sector-17 A, Chandigarh** sharply at **09.00 AM** (due to COVID related protocol). You are required to make your own travel arrangements. However, for initial joining, you will be reimbursed travelling expenses from the place of residence/previous employment by the shortest route. The entitlement for the purpose will be AC II tier train fare.

3. Your appointment will be subject to satisfactory completion of pre-appointment formalities including the following:

- a) Medical examination by Bank's Doctor and his satisfactory report/clearance after medical examination as may be conducted by him.
- b) Verification of certificates / testimonials in original evidencing the date of birth, caste, experience (if applicable), educational qualifications etc.
- c) Execution of Bond/Undertaking to serve the Bank for a minimum period of 3 years from the date of joining the Bank and to pay a sum of Rs. 2.00 lac (Rs. Two lac only), plus applicable GST, to the Bank in the event of your resignation from the services of the Bank or you leaving the Bank for whatsoever reason within the said period of 3 years in the format provided by the Bank.

In case you are serving elsewhere, please arrange to furnish a release/ discharge letter from your present employer by that date.

4. Your basic pay will be Rs. 41,960/- p.m. in the Junior Management Grade Scale I, i.e. 4 increments above the first stage of JMGS I pay-scale Rs. 36000- 1490/7 - 46430 - 1740/2 - 49910 - 1990/7 - 63840 with effect from the date of joining. You will be entitled to Dearness Allowance, House Rent Allowance and other allowance(s) depending upon the place of posting, and contributory Provident Fund as per rules of the Bank. Further, in terms of Rule 45(ii) of State Bank of India Officer's Service Rules, you will be eligible to become member of Defined Contribution Pension Scheme or New Pension Scheme of the Bank subject to such terms and conditions as may be stipulated by the bank.

5. You will be on probation for a period of two years from the date of appointment. Your date of appointment shall be the date on which you actually join the Bank. Your confirmation in the Bank shall be subject to:

- a) Receipt of satisfactory reports on you from two referees nominated by you and acceptable to the Bank.
- b) Satisfactory reports from our own sources as well as from District/ Police Authorities regarding your character and antecedents.
- c) Satisfactory completion of the in-service training during probation.
- d) Satisfactory completion of mandated e-lessons as may be prescribed by the Bank from time to time.
- e) Satisfactory performance in the branches/offices allotted, continuous assessment including pre-joining assessment during the probation period and completion of prescribed certificate courses. Unsatisfactory performance in the evaluation/ tests will be dealt with as per the guidelines/ instructions of the Bank in force at the time of conducting evaluation/ tests.

6. Please note that your service in the Bank will be governed by the SBI Officers' Service Rules, 1992 as amended from time to time, and the instructions/ guidelines issued/ other rules and

regulations framed by the Bank from time to time. A copy of the Service Rules will be provided to you on your joining the Bank. You will be required to sign a declaration of fidelity and secrecy and code of conduct of the Bank while using internet or social media, copies of which will be given to you at the time of joining.

7. You are required to join the Bank positively on **30.03.2021**. In exceptional cases and for valid reasons, requests for extension in date of joining (with the current batch / or with the next batch) may be considered by the Bank on a case to case basis. For joining with the current batch, only one extension shall be granted for joining on **28.06.2021**. No request for extension in time beyond **28.06.2021** for the current batch shall be permitted. In case extension is sought beyond that date, you may only be permitted to join with the next batch of Probationary Officers. 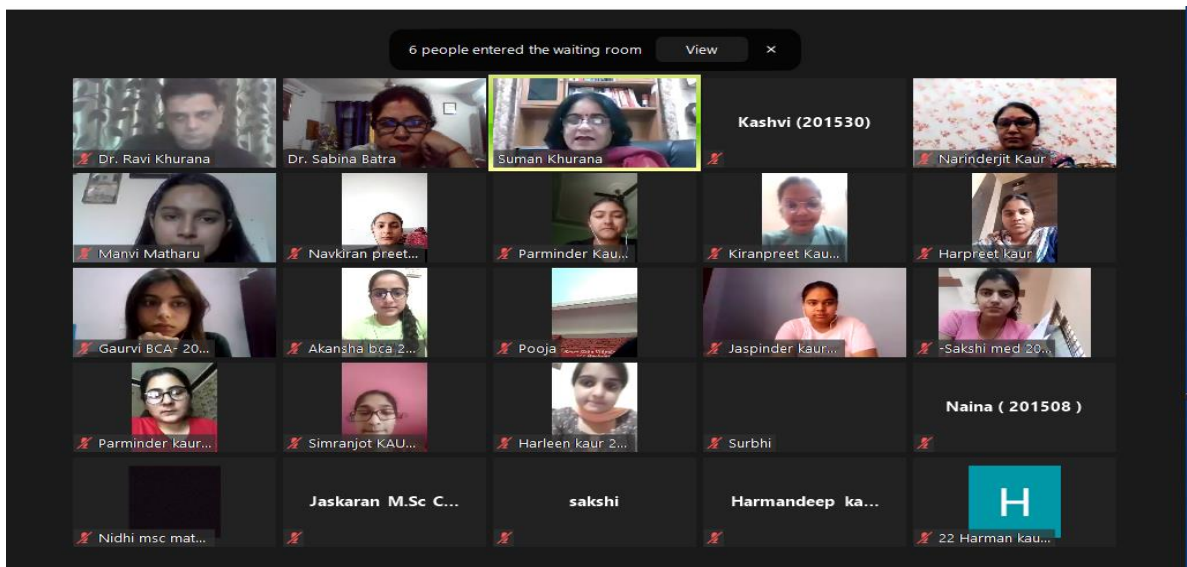
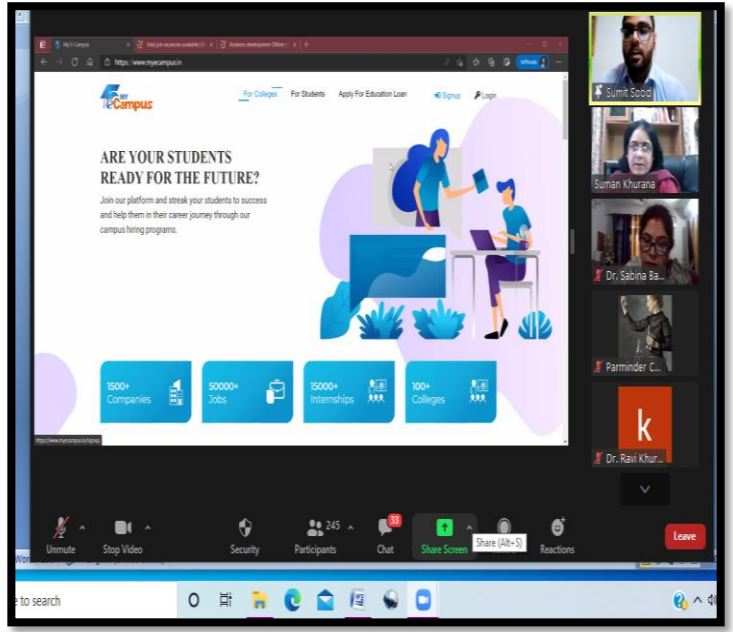
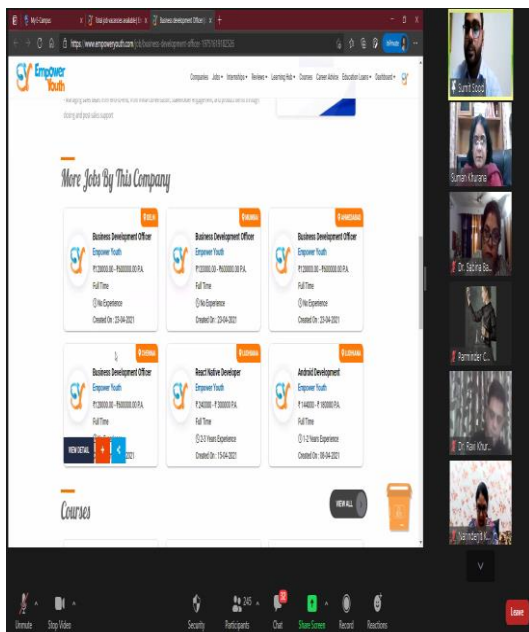
ORIENTATION WORKSHOP ON CAREER PROSPECTS

April 26th, 2020

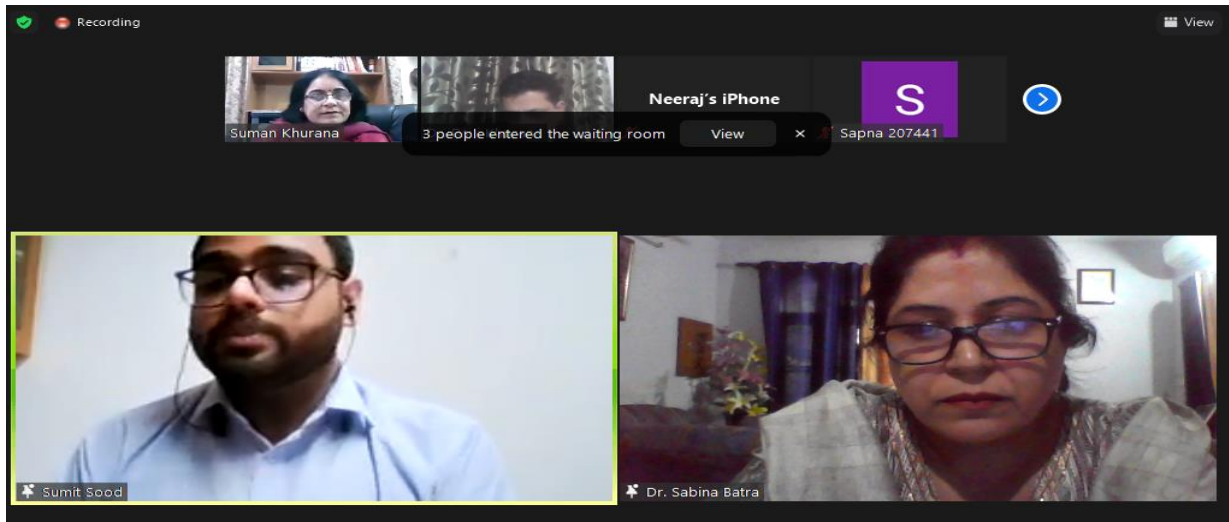
