## Social Outreach Value Added Programme

To inculcate a sense of responsibility among the students towards various social issues, KMV has started social outreach as a value added programme. It proposes to equip the students for community upliftment work. The social outreach value added program initiated by a motivating presentation by Principal Dr. Atima Sharma Dwivedi who has introduced such pioneering programmes in the region. This is followed by Lectures by Various resource Persons, who introduced the areas in which students can undertake projects. This year 434 students undertook Projects:- Literacy Drive, Environment Protection and Sustainability, Medical camps, Food Adulteration Camps, Running Empathy Corners, Visits to Pingalwaras, Orphanages and Old Age Homes, Spreading Awareness through social media(uploading short videos), spreading social awareness through Nukkad Nataks.
