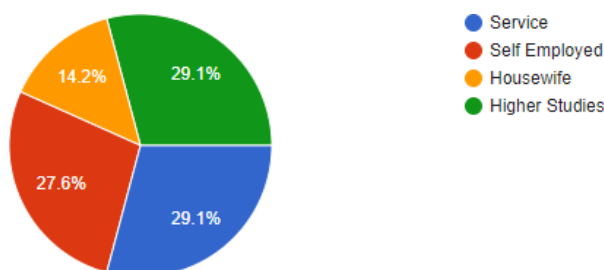

Status of Alumni

Twenty eight percent are self employed, twenty nine percent are working , Twenty nine percent are pursuing further studies and fourteen percent are staying at home.

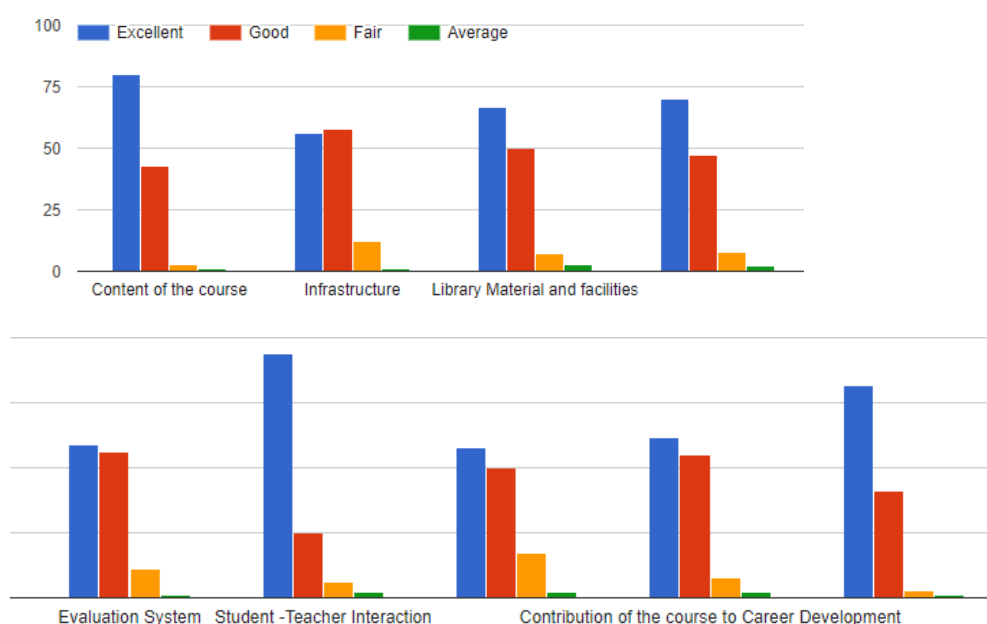
The major findings are as follows :



- *Almost all the alumni find content of the course excellent or good.*
- *Nearly forty two percent alumni find infrastructure excellent and nearly forty six percent of alumni perceive it good.*
- *Nearly fifty five percent perceive library material and facilities excellent and forty percent find it good*
- *Co-curricular and extension activities organized by student centric*

societies are marked excellent by nearly fifty seven percent alumni and good by nearly thirty eight percent

- *Nearly forty three percent alumni find evaluation system excellent and nearly same percentage find it good*
- *Nearly seventy five percent alumni feel student-teacher interaction excellent and twenty percent perceive it good.*
- *Nearly forty six percent alumni find working of placement cell & career counseling excellent and forty percent observe it good .*
- *Contribution of curriculum towards career development is observed excellent or good by almost all the alumni .*
- *Overall academic environment is found to be excellent by nearly sixty three percent students .*
