

Alumni Feedback on Curriculum

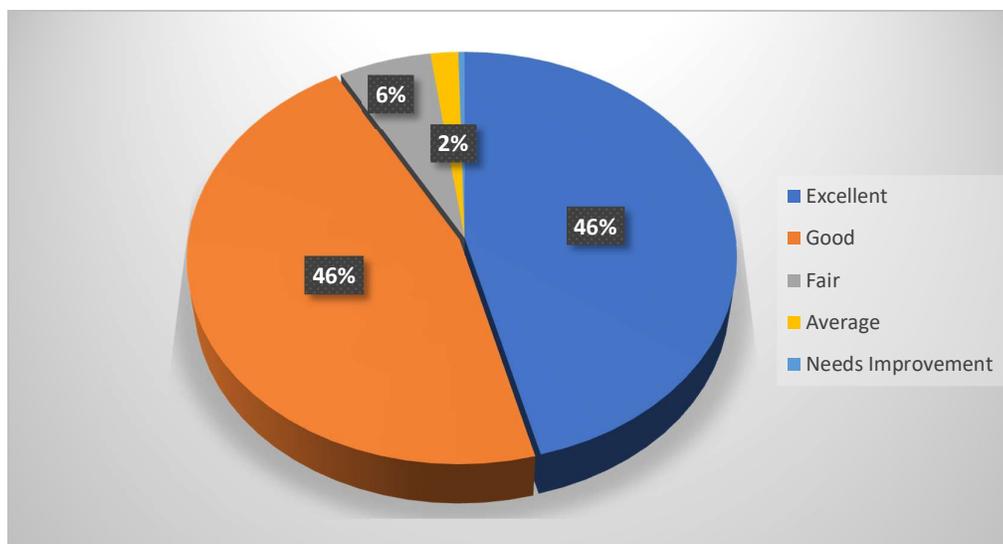

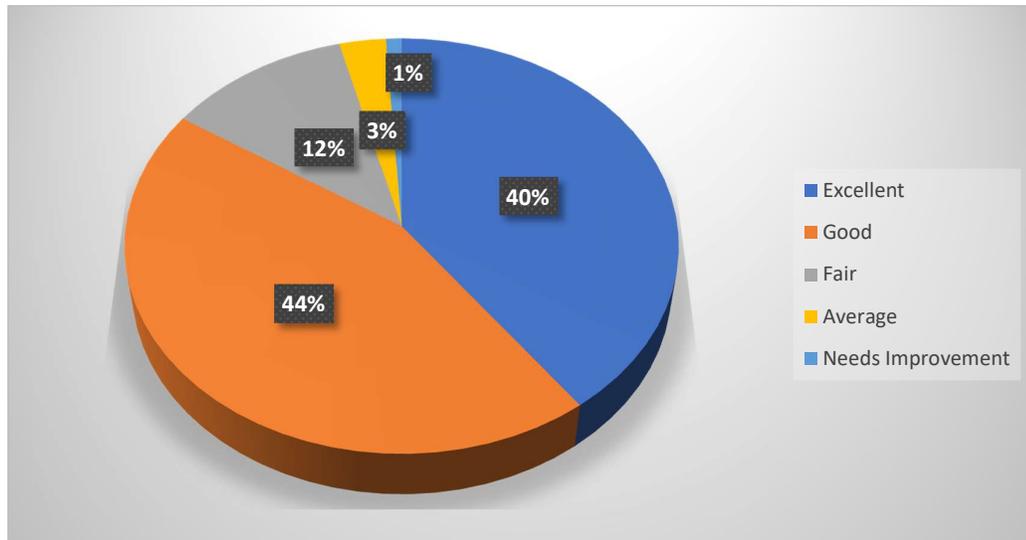
The views and opinions of alumni about the syllabi and various facilities have been analyzed on a five-point likert scale. The major findings are as follows:

- **Course Curriculum**-Forty-Six percent of alumni find the course curriculum excellent, another forty-six percent of alumni find it good, while 6 percent find it average.

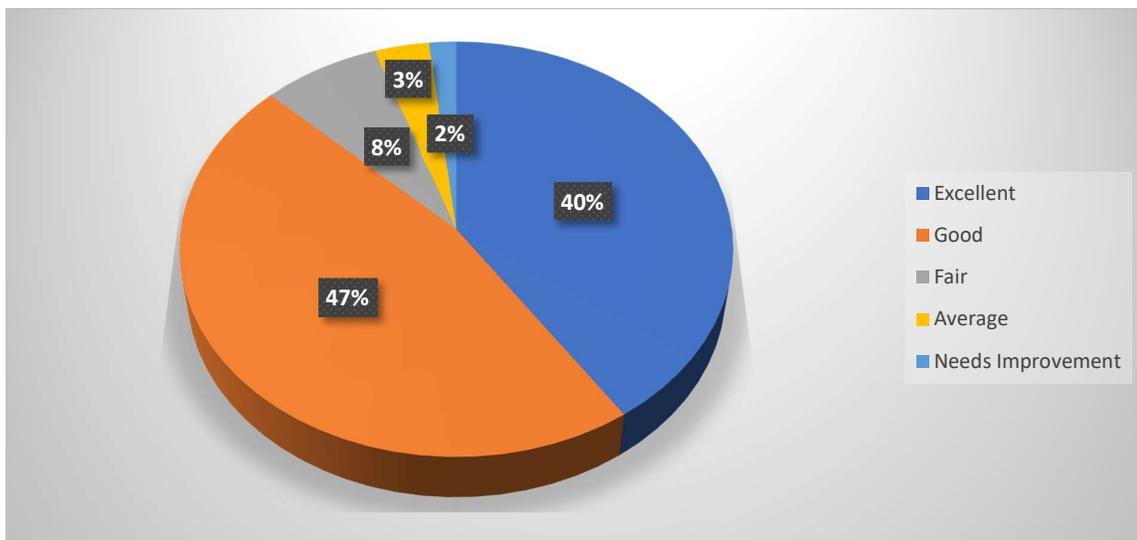


- **Relevance of Course Content**-Forty percent of alumni consider the relevance of course content to the current job/real-life excellent and the other forty-four percent of alumni consider it good. While other twelve percent of alumni find the fair and the remaining

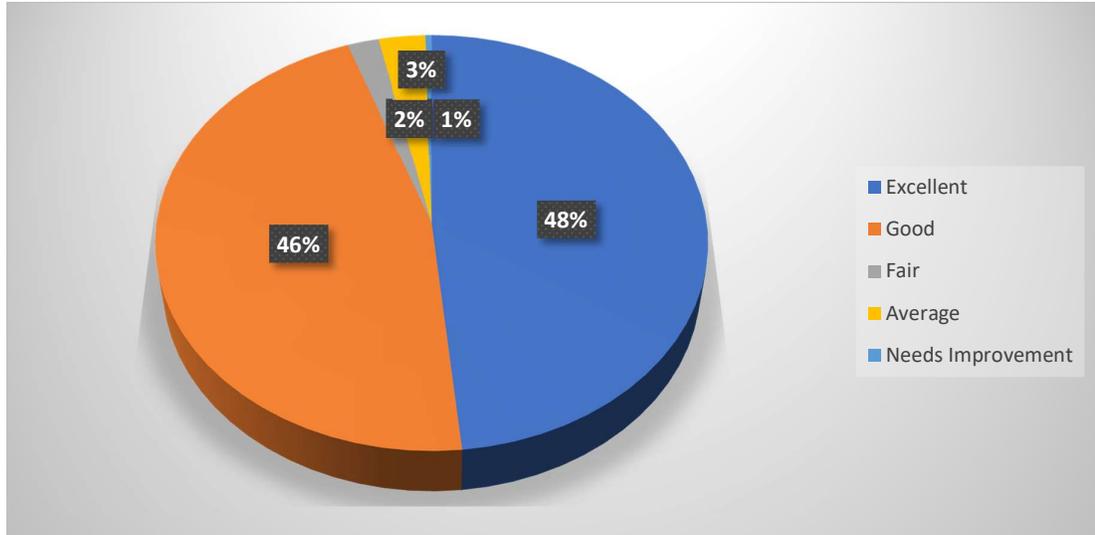
three percent say that there is average relevance of course content to the current job/real life.



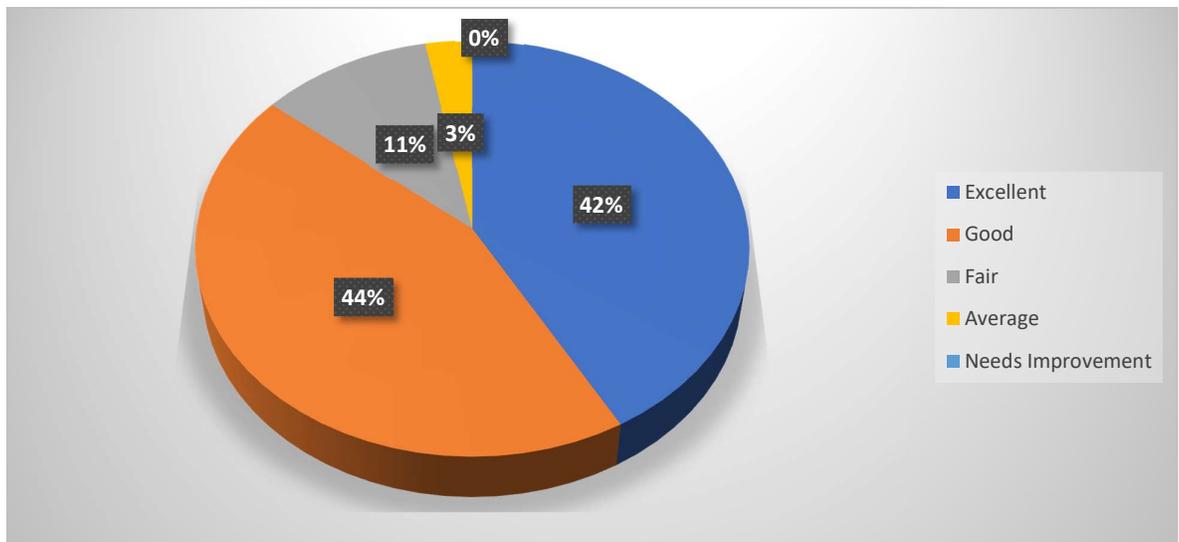
- **Skill and Practical Component**-Forty percent of alumni find the skill and practical components excellent, the other forty find it good and another eight percent of alumni find it fair while rest three percent find the skill and practical components average in the course structure and two percent needs some improvement.



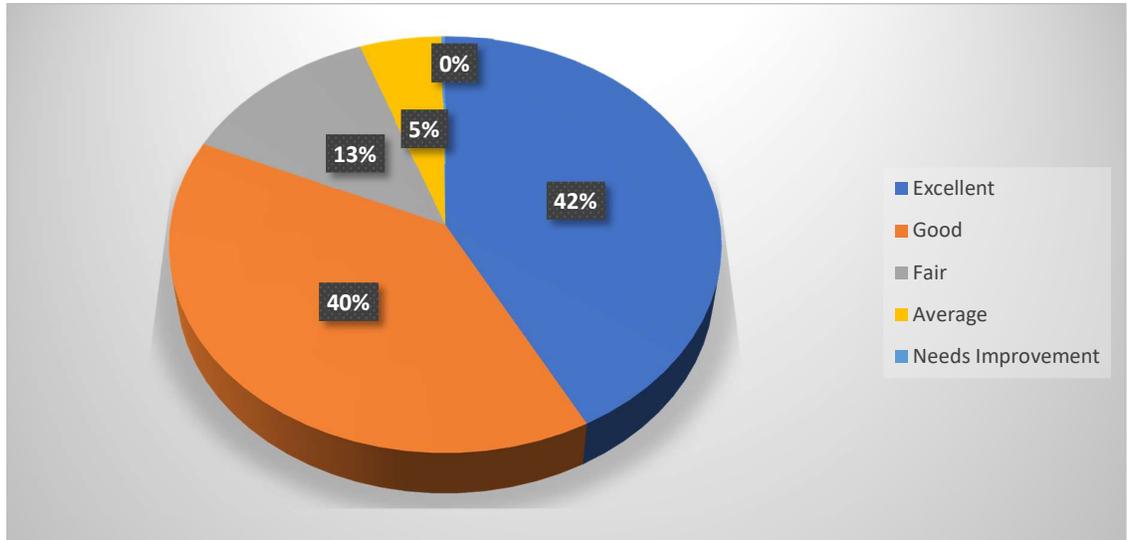
- **Quality of Teaching and Learning**-Forty-eight percent of alumni find the quality of teaching and learning excellent while other forty-six percent find it good while other three percent of alumni find the quality of teaching and learning average.



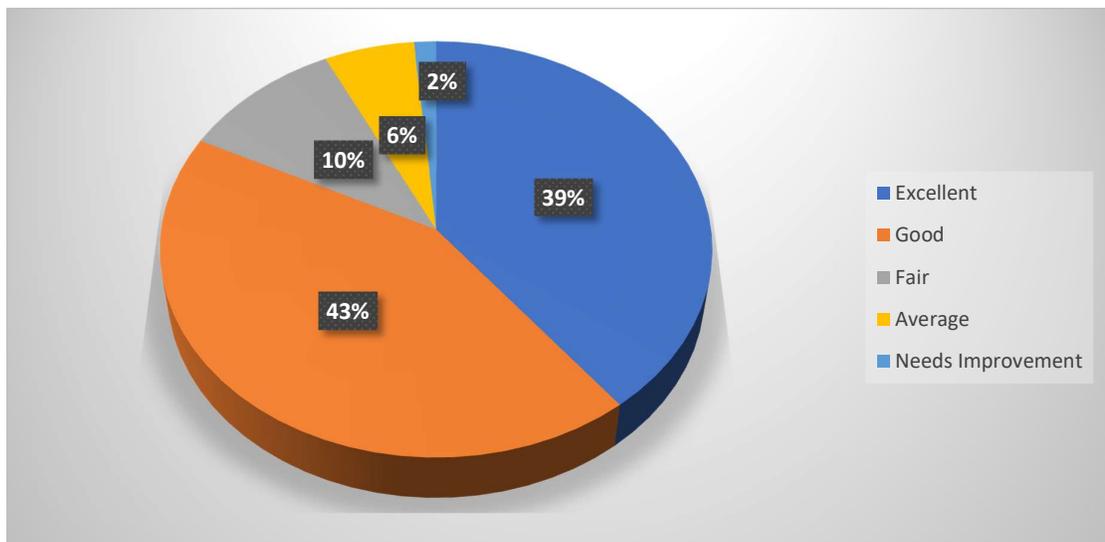
- **Co-curricular Activities and Development Initiatives** -Forty-four percent of alumni find co-curricular activities and development initiatives by the department/college excellent while other forty-two percent of alumni find it good. Other eleven percent find it fair and the remaining three percent find that these co-curricular activities and development initiatives average.



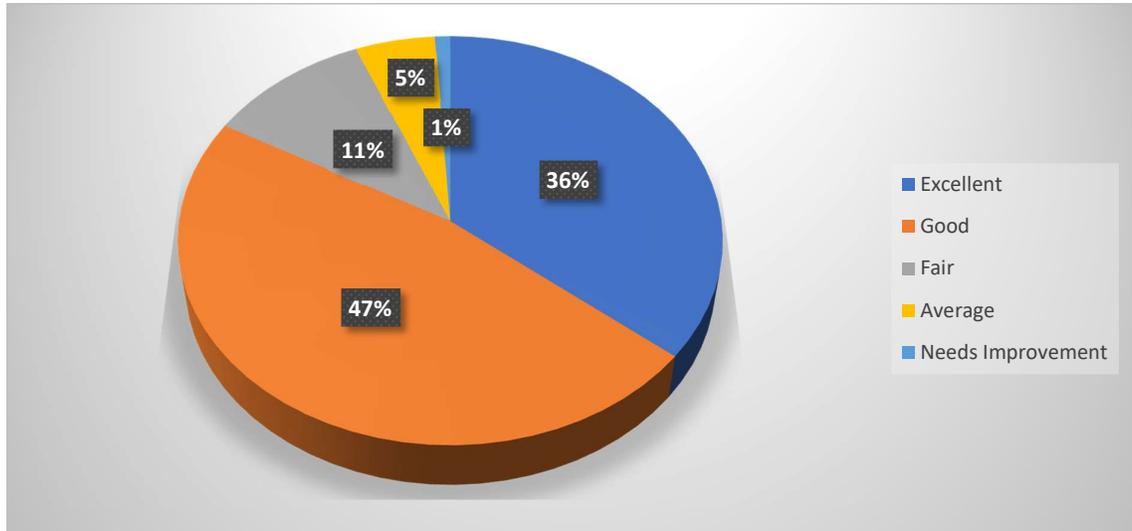
- **Library Facilities** -Forty-two percent of alumni find library facilities excellent and forty percent find it good. Other thirteen percent say library facilities are fair, five percent say average.



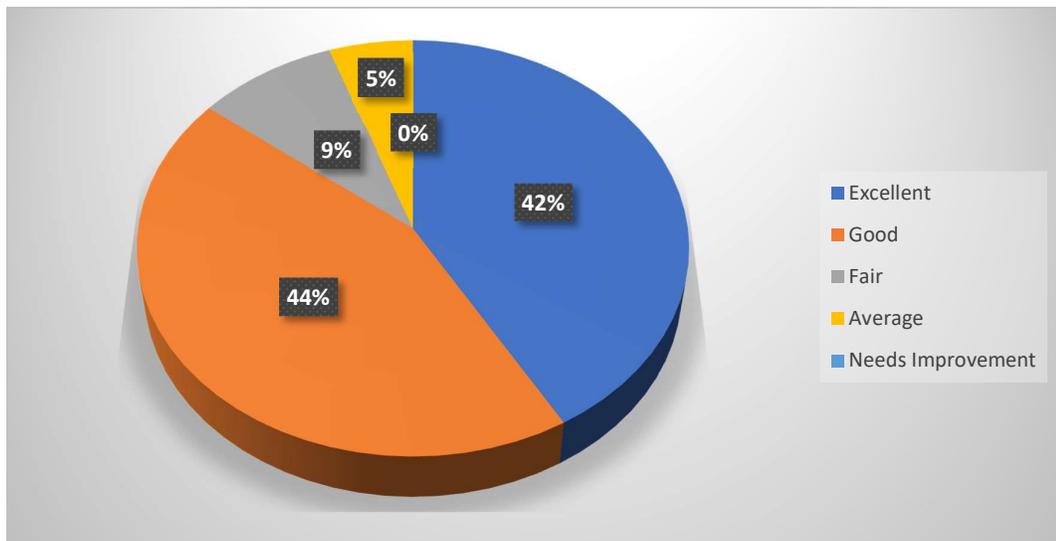
- **Infrastructure and Lab Facilities**-Thirty-nine percent of alumni advocate that Infrastructure and lab facilities are excellent and the other forty-three advocate these facilities as good. While the other ten percent find these facilities fair, six percent find them average and the remaining two percent said that Infrastructure and lab facilities need improvement.



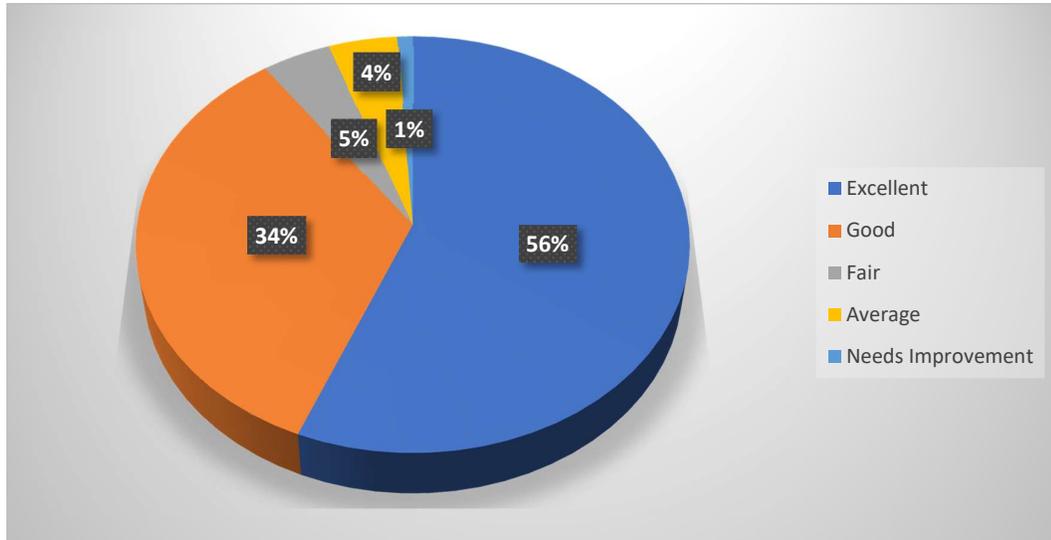
- **Placement Cell**-Thirty-six percent of alumni consider working of placement cell excellent and the other forty-seven percent of alumni find it good. 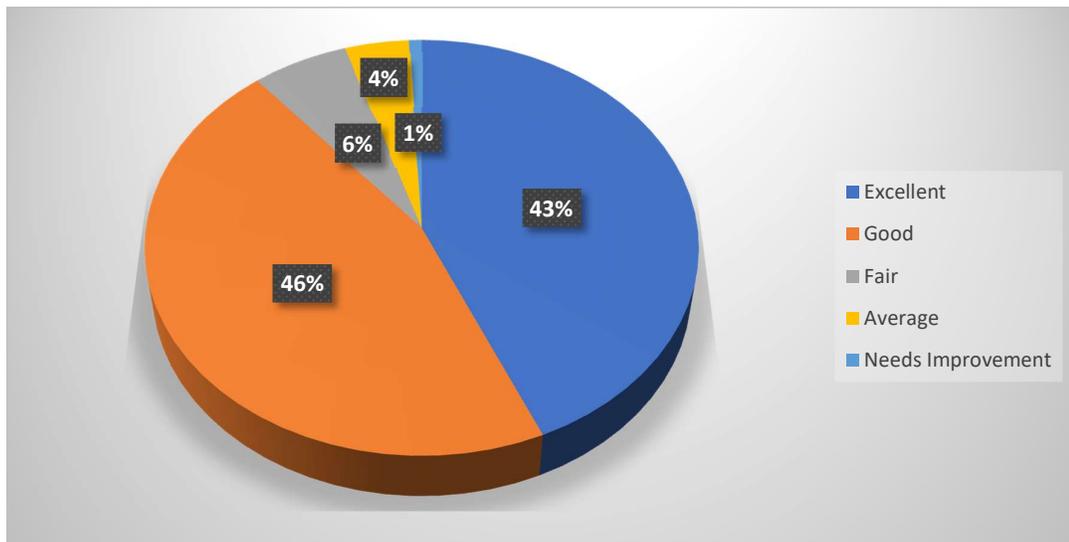

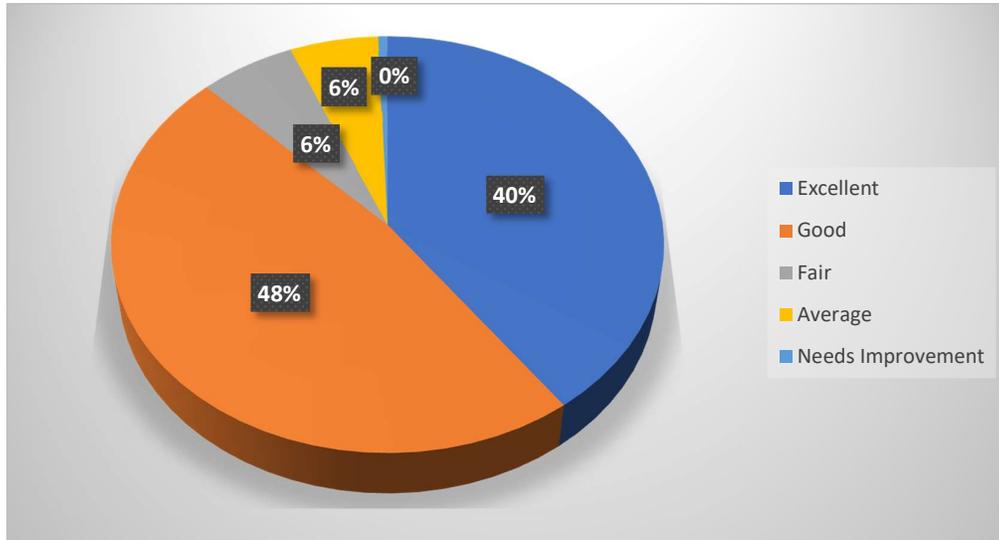

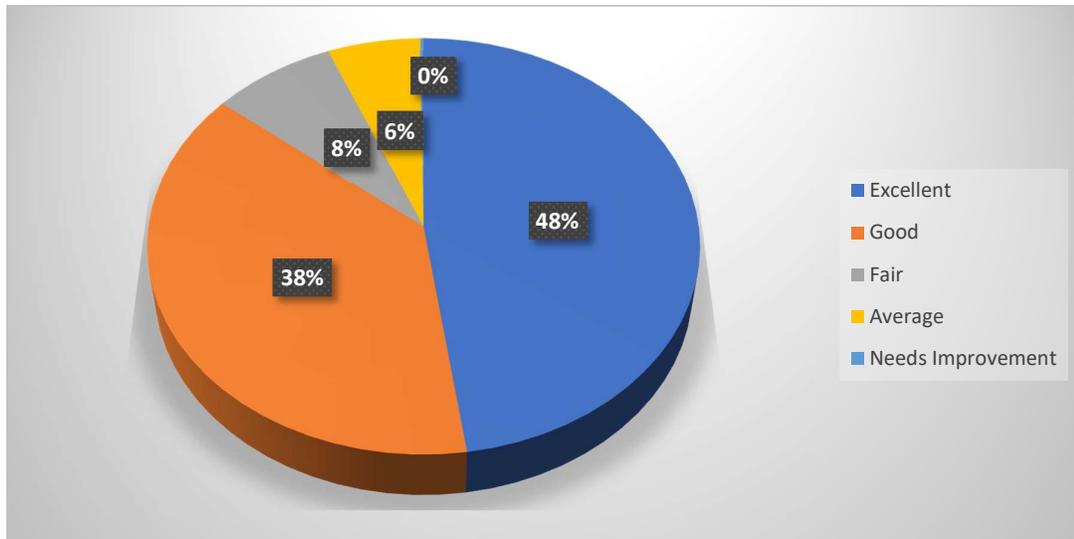

- **Redressal of Grievances Mechanism-** Forty percent of alumni find the redressal of grievances mechanism excellent and the other forty-eight percent of alumni find it good. While six percent find it fair, the remaining six percent find it average.



- **Overall Campus Environment**-Forty-eight percent of alumni find the overall environment of the institution excellent and the other thirty-eight find it good, eight percent find it fair and the remaining six percent find it average.
