Unit- II

Lenses: Different types of lenses and their application. Lighting: Lights and lighting, Basics of lighting, Techniques, Different types of lights used in videography, Use of filters & reflectors.

Unit- III

Introduction to video editing; Importance of video editing; Types of video editing: linear editing, non-linear editing, online editing, offline editing; Framing, Line of Action.

Unit-IV

Ingesting footage, making project file, project setting, time line operations.

Basic transition devices- cut, dissolve, wipe, fade; Visual effects; - Chroma key; inserting graphics and images; Motion; Multi-images, Export options.
