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VALUE-ADDED PROGRAMME “INNOVATION, ENTREPRENEURSHIP AND CREATIVE THINKING”

Kanya Maha Vidyalaya has taken lead in introducing a value-added programme “Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Creative Thinking” for the final year students of undergraduate degree programmes. The programme focuses on the interconnection between entrepreneurial thinking and innovation, and covers relevant topics like- Creativity & Innovation, Entrepreneurial Competencies, Management Skills & Functions, Business Opportunity Identification & Market Analysis, Business Plan Preparation, Business Model Canvas, Start-Up Financing & Launching, and Design Thinking.





KMV-IIC MEMBERS PARTICIPATED IN A SERIES OF INNOVATION AMBASSADOR TRAINING PROGRAMMES CONDUCTED BY MIC, GOVT. OF INDIA

KMV's Innovation Ambassadors completed various activities as prescribed and suggested by IIC, MIC. Innovation Ambassadors conducted activities at regular intervals to create awareness, inculcate entrepreneurial mindset, and bring cognizance about start-ups, IPR, and the importance of innovation ecosystem enablers and facilitators among students and fellow faculty members. **17 IIC members have undergone innovation ambassador training for basic and advanced level. 6 members have reached the higher level of training, i.e., upskilling. Total number of I&E Expert Talks/Sessions Conducted by IAs is 201.**

CREATION OF INNOVATION PIPELINE AND PATHWAYS FOR ENTREPRENEURS AT INSTITUTE LEVEL

KMV organises impact lectures, workshops, seminars and mentoring sessions wherein expert sessions are held addressing critical issues faced by entrepreneurs ranging from business plan writing, funding, risk management and financial analysis to various opportunities and challenges for an entrepreneur in various sectors. Students are encouraged to develop entrepreneurial mindset through experiential learning by exposing them to training in cognitive skills (e.g., design thinking, critical thinking, etc.), by inviting first generation local entrepreneurs or experts to address young minds. As many as 67 activities were performed by KMV-IIC in collaboration with different departments.



STUDENT CLUB-WOMENTUM

Student club 'WOMENTUM' is engaged in promotion of Innovation and Entrepreneurship in the campus. The members are involved in creating awareness among faculty and students regarding innovation, entrepreneurship, start-ups, etc. by organising various competitions. The members also participate in various national and international competitions organised on the theme of innovation and entrepreneurship.

STUDENT PARTICIPATION IN NATIONAL LEVEL COMPETITIONS

KMV students developed a prototype of futuristic driverless car. The idea behind this project was to visualize the futuristic driverless car with essential safety features as the future of roads. Just an oral or a written command to the vehicle interface would lead to the desired destination. This innovative idea of students of Kanya Maha Vidyalaya, Jalandhar has got selected in TOYCATHON-2021. Two students along with two faculty members of KMV, Jal. participated at nodal centre Panipat Institute of Engineering and Technology, Panipat. KMV Jalandhar was the only institute from Jalandhar who have got shortlisted to participate in the event. In this three-day program, the judges challenged participants' creativity by giving different problems. Students successfully completed all the levels and ended up with designing of brand-new android-based application.




INNOVATION & ENTREPRENEURSHIP AWARD






e-LEARNING REPOSITORY
