They should prepare academic calendar before vacations and submit to IQAC.

- 2. She asked teachers to promote each department through social media.
- 3. Department achievement like Job placements, International standard as well as college collaboration must be shared with students
- 4. Regarding research every department should have at least 2 Publications in Scopus. Principal Madam asked about publication from HODs and took feedback from HODs about papers published in their departments. Principal Madam praised some departments which have good publications. She also asked HODs to also involve students in research.

- 5. She also apprised HODs about Academic Council meeting decision regarding credit based system which will be introduced after maturing autonomy.
- 6. It is decided that credit system for PG will be postponed by one year. System will be in CES at present. Credit based system will be implemented later on as per UGC guidelines
- 7. During 2019-20, Credit based system will only be for B.Voc and M.Voc classes
