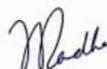

Madam Principal Prof. (Dr.) Atima Sharma Dwivedi welcomed the industry trainers – Ms. Karishma Arora from Rubicon Skill Development and Ms. Anju Jain from Naandi Foundation – Mahindra Group and extended them best wishes for the sessions.

The Course was planned for five days and executed for six days in association with Maharashtra based Skill Development Company – Rubicon Skill Development Inc. and Naandi Foundation – Mahindra Group. The training sessions were implemented as 4 batches per day – two batches by Rubicon and two batches by Mahindra Group per day for 5 working days and the last day was fixed for Mock interviews. The company officials implemented this Course on different Program Modules like Organizational Structure, Public Speaking, Presentation Skills, Group Discussion and Mock interviews that are quite relevant in the working environment – were taken up very nicely by their learned trainers – Ms. Karishma Arora from Rubicon and Ms. Anju Jain from Naandi Foundation – Mahindra Group.

In addition to this, KMV faculty also trained and guided the students on different modules. Dr. Suman Khurana, Dean - Placement Cell KMV took a session on “Resume’ Writing, Group Discussion and SWOT Analysis” and Ms. Vandana Sharma – Asstt. Prof. Dept. of Computer Sc. & Appls. department took a session on “Recent Job Markets.”

The students were evaluated based on Multiple-Choice Quiz and/or practice/mock tests with Internal Assessment and end semester exam and they were graded accordingly. 213 students got benefitted by this Course.
