

Students' Feedback on Curriculum





The views and opinions of students about the syllabi and various facilities have been analyzed properly. The major findings are as follows:


- 54 percent of students find the curriculum of their concerned subjects challenging and 46 percent find it simple.




- ❖ 36 percent of students feel that the curriculum always provokes meaningful discussions in the classes and 50 percent of students feel that the curriculum mostly provokes meaningful discussions in the classes.




- ❖ 52 percent of students agree that syllabi of different subjects are always completed in time while 43 percent agree that it is mostly completed in time.



- ❖ 22 percent of students agree that there are more than adequate library materials and facilities for the course and 73 percent consider it adequate. 5 percent of students want improvement in the library facilities.




- ❖ 29 percent of students express high satisfaction with the availability of choice of the subjects while a notably high percentage i.e. 68 percent of students express satisfaction over it.



- **69 percent of students favor internal assessment in the curriculum and only 29 percent of students do not favor this.**




- ❖ **29 percent of students find the examination system excellent and 60 percent of students find it good.**




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
- ❖ **69 percent students say that fieldwork in the curriculum is adequate and 27 percent consider it more than adequate. 6 percent students want more exposure in field.**




- **35 percent of students find lab facilities to be excellent and 53 percent of students find it good. 12 percent believe that it can be improved.**



- **41 percent of students consider curriculum extremely helpful in enhancing career prospects and 58 percent consider it somewhat helpful.**



- **59 percent of students find the curriculum extremely helpful in enhancing skill base and knowledge and 39 percent find it somewhat helpful.**



Suggestions for New Courses

1. KMV should introduce courses like 4-year integrated course B.A./B.Sc.-B.Ed., M.B.A, Hotel Management, and LLB etc.
2. Introduce Data Science as a compulsory subject for BCA students also
3. Physical Chemistry as a subject should be included in B.Sc. Biotech 5 rather than B.Sc. Biotech 6.

4. M.Sc. Biotechnology and Forensic Science should be introduced.

Other Suggestions

- CP-I and CP-II should not be taken.
- Compulsory industrial training should be made part of the curriculum
- More focus should be given to practical and skill-based knowledge, fieldwork, projects, and training sessions.
- More industrial visits or educational visits should be arranged.
- Separate extra classes should be arranged for DBT-JRF, ICMR, IIT-JAM, CSIR-NET.

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
