Minutes:-

Ms. Hardeep Kaur, CoE, presented the result analysis report of December 2022 ESE (Odd Semesters). The key points of the report are:

- Last Theory Examination was conducted on 02-01-2023, however, last Practical examinations and training viva voce was conducted on 11-02-2023 for Bachelor of vocation (Nutrition, Exercise and Health) Semester-III. The first result was declared on 22-12-2022 and the last result was declared on 15-03-2023. The average days taken to declare all the results were calculated as 37 working days. All the semester-V results were declared within 33 average days.
- Results of 133 different programmes (Semester I, III, V and VII) of December 2022 ESE (Odd Semesters) have been declared. Out of 133 declared results of 58 programmes are 100%, and that of 56 programmes lie between 75% to 99%, 13 declared results are between 60% to 74%, and 6 results are between 50% to 59%. The detail of results of May 2022 ESE is as under:



- Total 1990 students are admitted in different programmes in session 2022-23 out of which 1946 students appeared in December 2022 ESE. Remaining 44 students of different programmes have not appeared in December 2022 ESE due to unquoted reasons.
- Results of 27 students are withheld due to different reasons such as: lack of documents, fee not paid, and students have not completed their internship etc.
- Results of 1919 students are declared out of which 1617 passed and 299 students of different programmes have got reappears in different courses.
- 3 students failed in December 2022 ESE.
- 643 students got distinctions, 1319 students passed with First Division and 228 students passed with Second Division.
- 41 students have applied for re-evaluation after the declaration of the results of the December 2022 ESE, out of which 12 students have their marks changed greater than five.

- i. The percentage of number of reappears of December 2022 increased since December 2020, however, these are decreased as compared to December 2018. The dip at December 2020 can be attributed to Pandemic COVID-19. The graphical variations in reappear percentage for consecutive five years is shown below



- j. Average Pass Percentage of December 2022 has increased continuously since December 2018.
- k. The percentage of distinctions and first divisions has increased monotonically until December 2021, but have been decreased in December 2022.
- l. The percentage of second divisions in December 2022 has decreased as compared previous years' results.
- m. The Result Analysis Report of December 2022 ESE (Odd Semesters) w.r.t. previous five years i.e. 2018-19, 2019-20 and 2020-21 along with Detailed Result Report of December 2022 ESE has been submitted to the chairperson of the meeting.

Minutes:-

Ms. Hardeep Kaur, CoE, presented the comprehensive overview of the examination results for May 2023 ESE (Even Semesters). The report analyzes key metrics including the pass percentage, number of reappears, first and second divisions etc. The Key points of the report are:

- a. Last Theory Examination was conducted on 08-06-2023, however, Last Practical Examination of viva voce was conducted on 31-07-2023 for Master of Science (Botany), Semester-II. The first result was declared on 24-05-2023 and the last result was declared on 02-08-2023. The average days taken to declare all the results were calculated as 10 working days. All the semester-VI results were declared within 9 average days.
- b. Result of Post Graduate Diploma in Nutrition and Dietetics, Semester-II has not been declared till the date of meeting as the students have a 3 months Internship and Training at Hospitals and they are still involved in that training.
- c. Results of 142 different programmes including certificate courses (Semester II, IV, VI and VIII) of May 2023 ESE (Even Semesters) have been declared. Out of 142, results of 82 programmes are 100%, and that of - 47 programmes lie between 75% to 99%, 8 programmes lie between 60% to 74% and 3 programmes lie between 50% to 59%. The detail of results of May 2023 ESE is as under:


- d. Total 1892 students are admitted in different programmes in session 2022-23 out of which 1885 students appeared in May 2023 ESE. Remaining 7 students of different programmes have not appeared in May 2023 ESE due to unquoted reasons.
- e. Results of 76 students are withheld due to different reasons such as: lack of documents, fee not paid and students have not completed their internship etc.
- f. Results of 1807 students are declared out of which 1630 passed and 164 students of different programmes have got reappears in different courses.
- g. 13 students failed in May 2023 ESE.
- h. 724 students got distinctions, 1429 students passed with First Division and 146 students passed with Second Division.
- i. 27 students have applied for re-evaluation after the declaration of the results of the May 2023 ESE, out of which 5 students have their marks changed greater than five.

- j. The percentage of number of reappears of May 2023 has decreased as compared to May 2022. The maximum increase in number of reappears amongst students in May 2022 can be attributed to the lingering effects of Covid. The pandemic disrupted the traditional mode of education and brought significant mental stress and anxiety for students resulting in influence on academic performance. The graphical variations in reappear percentage for consecutive five years is shown below:-



- k. Average Pass Percentage has increased in May 2023 as compared to May 2022 indicating that the students are performing better in academics.
- l. The increase in percentage of distinctions and first divisions in May 2023 signifies the excellent performance of students in comparison of May 2022.
- m. The percentage of second divisions in May 2023 has increased continuously since May 2020.
- n. **Highlights of Final Semester Results**

Total 533 students of UG and 155 of PG Degree Programmes appeared in their final semester. Out of which results of only 474 and 148 students were respectively declared. The results of 59 students of UG and 7 students of PG were withheld due to various reasons including lack of documents, fee not paid, previous result etc. 24 students of UG and 3 student of PG got reappears in various courses. Out of 474 students of UG Degree Programme, only 450(94%) are eligible for the award of degree. Whereas out of 148 students of PG Degree Programmes, only 145(98%) are eligible

for the award of degree. 190 students of UG and 68 students of PG Degree Programme got distinctions in their final semester. 87% students of UG and 94% students of PG got their degree with first division.

- a. The Result Analysis Report of May 2023 ESE (Even Semesters) w.r.t. previous four years i.e. 2018-19, 2019-2020, 2020-21 and 2021-22 along with Detailed Result Report of May 2023 ESE has been submitted to the chairperson of the meeting.
